RESOLUTION NO. BG 2020- 0023

WHEREAS, the BASES CONVERSION AND DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY (BCDA) has put on bid the **Procurement for Fit-Out, Repair, Local Area Network, Supply and Delivery of IT Equipment and Software for the Subic-Clark Railway Project Management Office** with the following Approved Budgets for the Contract (ABCs), inclusive of all applicable government taxes and fees, through the FY 2019 General Appropriations Act (GAA) as amended by RA 11464;

WHEREAS, the **BAC-G**, through its Secretariat, advertised the Invitation to Bid on 01 December 2020 in the following:

- a. DBM Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS);
- b. BCDA Website; and
- c. In a conspicuous place reserved for the purpose in the premises of BCDA.

WHEREAS, in response to the said advertisements, the following four (4) companies submitted their bids before the deadline for submission of bids for the following lots:

Lot A	Three in One Construction and Trading
Lot B	Pronet Systems Integrated Network Solution, Inc.
Lot C	Kollab Guru Group Inc.
Lot D	CIM Technologies, Inc

WHEREAS, during the Opening of Bids on 23 December 2020, the BAC-G received and opened proposals of the above-mentioned bidders. During this activity, the eligibility and technical documents submitted by the bidder for **Lot A** of the **Fit-Out, Repair, Local Area Network, Supply and Delivery of IT Equipment and Software for the Subic-Clark Railway Project Management Office, Three in One Construction and Trading** did not pass the initial evaluation because it did not submit the mandatory documentary requirements, therefore, BAC-G found **Three in One Construction and Trading** to be **ineligible** and its financial proposal was left unopened.

On the other hand, the eligibility and technical documents submitted by the bidders for Lot B, Lot C, and Lot D of the **Fit-Out, Repair, Local Area Network, Supply and Delivery of IT Equipment and Software for the Subic-Clark Railway Project Management Office** have passed the preliminary evaluation. These three (3) bidders were found eligible, thus, their financial proposals were opened;

WHEREAS, after the careful evaluation of the submitted bids, the BAC for Goods noted the following observations:

1. **Pronet Systems Integrated Network Solution, Inc.** passed the eligibility requirements and technical proposal, and submitted a financial proposal of **Nine Hundred Eighty- Eight Thousand Three Hundred Ninety-Nine Pesos (Php988,399.00)**, inclusive of all applicable taxes and fees for **Lot B**, which is below the ABC, thus, **Pronet Systems Integrated Network Solution, Inc.** was declared the Single Calculated Bid for **Lot B**;
2. **Kollab Guru Group Inc.** passed the eligibility requirements and technical proposal, and submitted a financial proposal of **One Hundred Forty-Eight Thousand Nine Hundred Seventy-One Pesos and 50/100 (Php148,971.50)**, inclusive of all applicable taxes and fees for **Lot C**, which is below the ABC, thus, **Kollab Guru Group Inc.** was declared the Single Calculated Bid for **Lot C**;
3. **CIM Technologies, Inc.** passed the eligibility requirements and technical proposal, and submitted a financial proposal of **One Hundred Ninety Thousand Pesos (Php190,000.00)**, inclusive of all applicable taxes and fees for **Lot D**, which is below the ABC, thus, **CIM Technologies, Inc.** was declared the Single Calculated Bid for **Lot D**;

The Abstract of Bids is hereby attached as “Annex “A”.

WHEREAS, in view of the foregoing statements and consistent with Section 34 of Rule X – Post-Qualification of the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9184, the BAC-G Technical Working Group (TWG) conducted a Post-Qualification on 28 December 2020 to determine if these companies: 1) Pronet Systems Integrated Network



Solution, Inc.; 2) Kollab Guru Group Inc.; and 3) CIM Technologies, Inc.; are compliant and responsive to the requirements and conditions specified in the Instructions to Bidders and Bid Bulletin No. BAC-G SCRP 2020-001;

WHEREAS, upon post-qualification conducted by the BAC-G TWG and after careful examination, validation, and verification of all the eligibility, technical, and financial documents submitted by these companies, BAC-G found that:

1. Pronet Systems Integrated Network Solution, Inc.'s bid for Lot B is compliant and responsive;
2. Kollab Guru Group Inc.'s bid for Lot C is compliant and responsive; and
3. CIM Technologies, Inc.'s bid for Lot D is compliant and responsive;

NOW, THEREFORE, foregoing premises considered, we, the members of the **BAC-G**, hereby **RESOLVE**, as it is hereby resolved, to recommend the following:


1. To declare **Pronet Systems Integrated Network Solution, Inc.** as the Single Calculated and Responsive Bid for the **Bidding of Lot B of Fit-Out, Repair, Local Area Network, Supply and Delivery of IT Equipment and Software for the Subic-Clark Railway Project Management Office** and to award the contract to **Pronet Systems Integrated Network Solution, Inc.** with the amount of **Nine Hundred Eighty- Eight Thousand Three Hundred Ninety-Nine Pesos (Php988,399.00)**, inclusive of all applicable taxes and fees;
2. To declare **Kollab Guru Group Inc.** as the Single Calculated and Responsive Bid for the **Bidding of Lot C of Fit-Out, Repair, Local Area Network, Supply and Delivery of IT Equipment and Software for the Subic-Clark Railway Project Management Office** and to award the contract to **Kollab Guru Group Inc.** with the amount of **One Hundred Forty-Eight Thousand Nine Hundred Seventy-One Pesos and 50/100 (Php148,971.50)**, inclusive of all applicable taxes and fees;
3. To declare **CIM Technologies, Inc.** as the bidder with the Single Calculated and Responsive Bid for the **Bidding of Lot D of Fit-Out, Repair, Local Area Network, Supply and Delivery of IT Equipment and Software for the Subic-Clark Railway Project Management Office** and to award the contract to **CIM Technologies, Inc.** with the amount of **One Hundred Ninety Thousand Pesos (Php190,000.00)**, inclusive of all applicable taxes and fees;
4. To declare a failure of bidding for **Lot A** and to recommend to the End-User to conduct a mandatory review and evaluation of the terms, conditions, and specifications in the Bidding Documents, including cost estimates and delivery

schedule of **Lot A of Fit-Out, Repair, Local Area Network, Supply and Delivery of IT Equipment and Software for the Subic-Clark Railway Project Management Office;**

5. To direct the End-user unit to furnish the BAC-G copies of the duly-conformed Notices of Award, Notices to Proceed and the duly executed agreements/contracts;
6. To proceed with the rebidding of the **Lot A of Fit-Out, Repair, Local Area Network, Supply and Delivery of IT Equipment and Software for the Subic-Clark Railway Project Management Office**, with an approved ABC, pursuant to Section 35.3 of the Revised IRR of RA 9184.
