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2. The interested bidders are reminded of Section 47 of the Revised IRR of R.A. 9184 under Rule XV- Disclosure of Relations which is quoted verbatim below:

Section 47.1 - "All bids shall be accompanied by a sworn affidavit of the bidder that it is not related to the HoPE, members of the BAC, the TWG, and the BAC Secretariat, the head of the PMO or the end-user or implementing unit, and the project consultants, by consanguinity or affinity up to the third civil degree. Failure to comply with the aforementioned provision shall be a ground for the automatic disqualification of the bid in consonance with Section 30 of this IRR. For this reason, relation to the aforementioned persons within the third civil degree of consanguinity or affinity shall automatically disqualify the bidder from participating in the procurement of contracts of the Procuring Entity notwithstanding the act of such persons inhibiting themselves from the procurement process. On the part of the bidder, this provision shall apply to the following persons:

- a) If the bidder is an individual or a sole proprietorship, to the bidder himself;
- b) If the bidder is a partnership, to all its officers and members;
- c) If the bidder is a corporation, to all its officers, directors, and controlling stockholders;
- d) If the bidder is a cooperative, to all its officers, directors, and controlling shareholders or members; and
- e) If the bidder is a joint venture, the provisions of items (a), (b), (c), or (d) of this Section shall correspondingly apply to each of the members of the said joint venture, as may be appropriate."

Section 47.2 - "All bidders also found to have conflicting interests with each other shall be disqualified to participate in the procurement at hand, without prejudice to the imposition of appropriate administrative, civil, and criminal sanctions. A bidder may be considered to have conflicting interests with another bidder in any of the events described in paragraphs (a) through (c) below and a general conflict of interest in any of the circumstances set out in paragraphs (d) through (j) below:

- a) A bidder has controlling shareholders in common with another bidder;
- b) A bidder receives or has received any direct or indirect subsidy from any other bidder;
- c) A bidder has the same legal representative as that of another bidder for purposes of this bid;
- d) A bidder has a relationship, directly or through third parties, that puts them in a position to have access to information about or influence on the bid of another bidder or influence the decisions of the Procuring Entity regarding this bidding process. This will include a firm or an organization who lends, or temporarily seconds, its personnel to firms or organizations which

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are engaged in consulting services for the preparation related to procurement for or implementation of the project if the personnel would be involved in any capacity on the same project;

- e) A bidder submits more than one bid in this bidding process. However, this does not limit the participation of subcontractors in more than one bid;
- f) A bidder who participated as a consultant in the preparation of the design or technical specifications of the Goods and related services that are the subject of the bid;
- g) A bidder who lends, or temporarily seconds, its personnel to firms or organizations which are engaged in consulting services for the preparation related to procurement for or implementation of the project, if the personnel would be involved in any capacity on the same project;
- h) If a consultant combines the function of consulting with those of contracting and/or supply of equipment;
- i) If a consultant is associated with, affiliated to, or owned by a contractor or a manufacturing firm with departments or design offices offering services as consultants unless such consultant includes relevant information on such relationships along with a statement in the technical proposal cover letter to the effect that the consultant shall limit its role to that of a consultant and disqualify itself and its associates from work in any other capacity that may emerge from the project (including bidding for any part of the future project). The contract with the consultant selected to undertake the project shall contain an appropriate provision to such effect; or
- j) If there is a conflict among consulting projects, the consultant (including its personnel and subcontractors) and any subsidiaries or entities controlled by such consultant shall not be recruited for the relevant project. The duties of the consultant depend on the circumstances of each case. While continuity of consulting services may be appropriate in particular situations where no conflict exists, a consultant cannot be recruited to carry out a project that, by its nature, shall result in conflict with a prior or current project of such consultant. Examples of the situations mentioned are when a consultant engaged to prepare engineering design for an infrastructure project shall not be recruited to prepare an independent environmental assessment for the same project; similarly, a consultant assisting a Procuring Entity in privatization of public assets shall not purchase, nor advise purchasers, of such assets; or a consultant hired to prepare terms of reference for a project shall not be recruited for the project in question.”

Any bidder, whether sole proprietor, partnership, firm, entity or Joint Venture, shall be disqualified if the bidder, or any member/partner of a partnership or Joint Venture (in case of Joint Venture), or any of its affiliate, subsidiary or entity affiliated therewith are barred, under existing and/or on-going contracts or covenants, from involvement in projects, especially master plan consultancy services, in the Clark Civil Aviation Complex.

3. Due to the recent pronouncement of the National Government extending the Modified Enhanced Community Quarantine (MECQ) until 15 September 2021 in the National Capital Region (NCR) and in nearby provinces, the **deadline for the submission and opening of the Eligibility Documents is moved to 20 September 2021**. Attached is the revised Timetable of Bidding Activities for the Project.

All other related provisions in the Terms of Reference, Bidding Documents or previous Bid Bulletins correspondingly affected by these amendments are likewise deemed amended to conform to this Bid Bulletin.

Amendments made herein shall be considered an integral part of the Bidding Documents.
