WHEREAS, the BASES CONVERSION AND DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY (BCDA) has approved the Bidding of Fit-out and Repair for the Subic-Clark Railway Project Management Office via Negotiated Procurement with the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) in the amount of Php2,850,000.00, inclusive of all applicable government taxes and fees, through the General Appropriations Act (GAA);

WHEREAS, the Bids and Awards Committee for Goods **(BAC-G)**, through its Secretariat, advertised the Invitation to Bid on 14 October 2021 in the following:

- a. DBM Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS);
- b. BCDA Website; and
- c. In a conspicuous place reserved for the purpose in the premises of BCDA.

WHEREAS, in response to the said advertisements, the following companies have responded, brought bidding documents, and submitted bid proposals before the deadline for submission of bids on 29 October 2021 at 12:00 PM:

- a. DCLABR03 Construction;
- b. Kalahan General Construction and Supplies;
- c. Jaymar Builders; and
- d. FPF Construction

WHEREAS, during the Opening of Bids on 29 October 2021, the BAC-G opened the bidding documents of the above-mentioned bidders and noted the following:

- a. Both DCLABR03 Construction and Jaymar Builders were declared eligible after the preliminary evaluation; and
- b. Both Kalahan General Construction and Supplies and FPF Construction have failed to submit complete eligibility and technical documents, therefore, they were declared non-eligible, as shown in the table below. Pursuant to Section 25.2. (a) vii of the RIRR of RA 9184, their financial proposals were left unopened:

WHEREAS, During the Technical Working Group's (TWG) detailed evaluation from 29 October to 03 November 2021, pursuant to Section 32 of Rule IX of the Revised IRR of RA 9184, the TWG noted a variance of P21,983.10 as follows:

WHEREAS, The submission of DCLABRO3 for item no. 5.5 (Glass partitions) is in sq.m and not in sq.ft as stated in the Terms of Reference;

WHEREAS, Upon conversion of the unit for the Glass partitions, per the requirement in the TOR, DCLABRO3's computation was overstated by P21,983.10 as shown in the table thereunder:

WHEREAS, pursuant to to Section 32.2.3(c) of the 2016 Revised IRR of RA 9184, in case of discrepancies, the actual sum of prices of component items shall prevail over the stated total price, thus the BAC-G considers the **Php 2,600,016.90** as the correct and final bid amount.

WHEREAS, DCLABRO3 Construction was declared as the Bidder with the Lowest Calculated Bid (LCB) with financial proposal amounting to Two Million Six Hundred Thousand Sixteen Pesos and 90/100 Only (Php 2,600,016.90), inclusive of VAT and all applicable taxes and fees, and was qualified for the post-qualification.

WHEREAS, BAC-G informed DCLABRO3 Construction in its letter of Post Qualification Notice dated 03 November 2021 that DCLABRO3 Construction's financial bid was in fact, the amount of Two Million Six Hundred Thousand Sixteen Pesos and 90/100 Only (Php 2,600,016.90), inclusive of all applicable taxes and fees;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Rule X of the RIRR of RA 9184, the Technical Working Group (TWG) of BAC-G conducted a post qualification with DCLABR03 Construction on 05-08 November 2021 to determine whether it complies with and is responsive to the requirements and conditions specified in the Bidding Documents for the Bidding of Fit-out and Repair for the Subic-Clark Railway Project Management Office via Negotiated Procurement;

WHEREAS, after the careful examination, validation, and verification of all the eligibility, technical, and financial documents submitted to the BAC-G by the DCLABRO3 Construction, its bid was declared Complying and Responsive (*Post Qualification Report attached as Annex B*).

NOW, THEREFORE, we, the Members of the Bids and Awards Committee for Goods, hereby **RESOLVE** as it is hereby **RESOLVED** to recommend the following:

- To declare DCLABR03 Construction as the Bidder with the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bid (LCRB) for the Bidding of Fit-out and Repair for the Subic-Clark Railway Project Management Office via Negotiated Procurement;
- To award the Contract to DCLABR03 Construction in the amount of Two Million Six Hundred Thousand Sixteen Pesos and 90/100 Only (Php 2,600,016.90), inclusive of all applicable taxes and fees;









- c. To issue the corresponding Notice of Award to DCLABR03 Construction (Copy Attached); and
- d. To direct the Subic Clark Railway Project (SCRP) PMO, being the end-user unit, to furnish the BAC-G copies of the duly conformed Notice of Award, Notice to Proceed and the duly executed agreement/contract.
