**RE-BIDDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF TWO (2) UNITS DEEP WELL AT
WALLACE AIR STATION, SAN FERNANDO LA UNION**

RESOLUTION NO. 16

(Declaration of Single Calculated and Responsive Bid)

The BASES CONVERSION AND DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY (BCDA), through the 2021 General Appropriations Act (GAA), has put on bid the **Contract** for the **Construction of Two (2) Units Deep Well at Wallace Air Station, San Fernando La Union**, with an Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) in the sum of **Pesos: Fourteen Million Five Hundred Ninety-Eight Thousand (Php 14,598,000.00)**, inclusive of all applicable taxes and fees, to be completed within One Hundred Twenty (120) calendar days.

WHEREAS, on 14 August 2021, the BAC-I, through the Secretariat, advertised the Invitation to Bid for the **Construction of Two (2) Units Deep Well at Wallace Air Station, San Fernando La Union** in the newspaper of nationwide circulation and from 13-20 August 2021 in the following:

1. DBM Philippine Government Electronics Procurement System (PhilGEPS)
2. BCDA Website
3. Conspicuous place in BCDA premises reserved for the purpose

WHEREAS, on 10 September 2021, only JASHV Construction and Supply purchased and submitted its bid before the deadline of submission of bids;

WHEREAS, on the same day, during the preliminary evaluation and after checking the sufficiency of the required documents as regards its presence or absence, the BAC rated the bid of JASHV Construction and Supply as “not passed” due to the absence or non-submission of the required Curriculum Vitae of the key personnel. The Curriculum Vitae of the nominated Key Personnel are supporting documents of the list of contractor’s key personnel required under Clause 10.4 of the Bid Data Sheet (BDS);

WHEREAS, based on the above results, the BAC-I has resolved the following through a BAC Resolution No. 9 dated 10 September 2021:

1. To declare a FAILURE OF BIDDING for the Construction of Two (2) Units Deep Well at Wallace Air Station, San Fernando La Union;
2. To conduct a mandatory review and evaluation of the terms, conditions, and specifications in the Bidding Documents, including its cost estimates, pursuant to Section 35.2 of the Revised IRR of RA 9184; and
3. To proceed with the re-bidding of the Construction of Two (2) Units Deep Well at Wallace Air Station, San Fernando La Union, based on the results of the aforementioned mandatory review pursuant to Section 35.3 of the Revised IRR of RA 9184.

WHEREAS, on 16 October 2021, after the conduct of mandatory review and evaluation of the terms, conditions, and specifications in the Bidding Documents, including its cost estimates, the BAC conducted the re-bidding by re-advertising the procurement for the **Re-Bidding for the Construction of Two (2) Units Deep Well at Wallace Air Station, San Fernando La Union** in the newspaper of nationwide circulation and from 16-23 October 2021 in the following:

1. DBM Philippine Government Electronics Procurement System (PhilGEPS)
2. BCDA Website
3. Conspicuous place in BCDA premises reserved for the purpose

WHEREAS, in response to the re-advertisement for the **Re-Bidding for the Construction of Two (2) Units Deep Well at Wallace Air Station, San Fernando La Union**, two (2) prospective bidders namely: 1) JASHV Construction Supply; and 2) FPF Construction purchased the bidding documents for the project;

WHEREAS, on 15 November 2021, only JASHV Construction and Supply submitted its bid prior to the deadline of submission of bids. After careful examination and deliberation of the submitted bids, from the preliminary evaluation stage up to the detailed evaluation stage, its bid has been found to be compliant with all the requirements and was rated as "passed";

WHEREAS, pursuant to BAC-I Resolution No. 13 dated 26 November 2021, **JASHV Construction and Supply** has been declared as the Single Calculated Bid (SCB) having offered a bid amounting to Pesos: **Fourteen Million Three Hundred Forty-Two Thousand Six Hundred Seven and 69/100 (Php14,342,607.69)**, inclusive of all applicable taxes and fees;

WHEREAS, the BAC-I through the Technical Working Group (TWG), conducted the post-qualification activities to determine whether the bidder concerned complies with and is responsive to all the requirement and conditions as specified in the Bidding Documents;

WHEREAS, after careful verification, validation and ascertainment of the authenticity of the submitted legal, technical, and financial documents, **JASHV Construction and Supply** has been found compliant with and responsive to all the requirement and conditions as specified in the Bidding Documents and the Revised IRR of RA 9184, therefore declared as POST-QUALIFIED to be awarded of the contract;


WHEREAS, **JASHV Construction and Supply**, is not blacklisted or barred from the bidding by the Government of the Philippines or any of its agencies, offices, corporations, or Local Government Units, as reflected in the Consolidated List of Blacklisted Contractors as of 30 November 2021 by the GPPB;

NOW, THEREFORE, foregoing considered and after careful evaluation and deliberation of the bids submitted for the Project, we, the Members of the Bids and Awards Committee for Infrastructure (BAC-I), hereby **RESOLVE**, as it is hereby **RESOLVED**:

1. To award the contract to **JASHV Construction and Supply** as the bidder with the **Single Calculated and Responsive Bid (SCRB)**, for the **Construction of Two (2) Units Deep Well at Wallace Air Station, San Fernando La Union** in the amount of Pesos: **Fourteen Million Three Hundred Forty-Two Thousand Six Hundred Seven and 69/100 (Php14,342,607.69)**, inclusive of all applicable taxes and fees, pursuant to Section 34.3 of the Revised IRR of RA 9184; and
2. To issue the corresponding Notice of Award (NOA) to **JASHV Construction and Supply** being the bidder with the SCRB.
