

**Procurement of Survey Grade Drone with Real Time Kinematic (RTK)  
and Light Detection and Ranging (LIDAR)**

**BID BULLETIN NO. BAC-G-RTK-2022-01**

This Bid Bulletin clarifies the queries that were raised during the Pre-Bid Conference on 02 December 2022 (Fri) at 1:00 PM and queries sent through e-mail by prospective bidders, as well as other matters relative to the **Procurement of Survey Grade Drone with Real Time Kinematic (RTK) and Light Detection and Ranging (LIDAR)**

QUERIES	CLARIFICATION/S
1. Source of fund	BCDA's CY 2022 Corporate Operating Budget (COB) and not the General Appropriations Act (GAA)
2. Clarification on Technical Specification, under Section 8. Other Requirements:  "The supplier must have at least five (5) years experience in LIDAR Mapping and software processing and must provide a company portfolio or any equivalent proof of experience relevant to LIDAR mapping and software processing."  Can this be relaxed to 1 year?	<b>YES.</b> We can reduce the minimum requirement to <b>at least one (1) year experience</b> in LIDAR mapping and software processing.  The supplier must at <b>least</b> be <b>knowledgeable with LIDAR mapping and software processing</b> and must provide any equivalent proof of experience relevant to LIDAR mapping and software processing.
3. Can the Light Detection and Ranging be separated?	<b>NO.</b> The Light Detection and Ranging cannot be separated because it is a package in itself, otherwise, it will defeat the purpose of procuring a Survey-Grade drone with RTK and LIDAR.
4. Technical Specification under Section 11.  "Bidders shall have the option to submit a proposal on any or all lots. Evaluation and contract award will be undertaken on a per lot basis."	Please note that the survey grade drone package is equivalent to <b>one (1) Lot only</b> , thus the provision is revised, to wit: <i>"Bidders shall submit one (1) proposal only. The evaluation and contract award shall be based on said proposal."</i>
5. Clarification on the venue, date, and time of the Submission of Bids of the prospective bidders	The prospective bidders may submit their bids on the following schedule and venue:  1) On or before 5:00 PM on 13 December 2022 at BCDA Central Receiving and Releasing Area, BCDA Office, Bonifacio Technology Center, Bonifacio Global City, Taguig City; <b>OR</b> 2) On or before 1:00 PM on 14 December 2022 at BCDA Central Receiving and Releasing Area, BCDA Office, 9th Floor, One West Aeropark Bldg., Clark Global City

5. TOR, no. 9. Mode of Delivery: Thirty (30) Days upon receipt of Purchase Order (PO)	For correction, it should be Thirty (30) Days upon issuance of Notice to Proceed (NTP).

The above changes further amend the bidding documents, accordingly. The Opening of Bids will be conducted face-to-face at the BCDA 9F One West Aeropark Building Industrial Estate - 5, Clark Global City Clark Freeport Zone, Mabalacat 2023 Pampanga. But the bidders may choose to attend the Opening of Bids in person or online, via zoom.

For those who are attending in person, the following guidelines must be followed:

- A maximum of two (2) persons per participating bidder are allowed to attend the Opening of Bids and shall be required to follow the BCDA Health Protocol for Visitors;
- The representative is required to present his/her vaccination card before he/she can be allowed inside the BCDA office;
- Compliance to social distancing, wearing of face masks, and body temperature screening inside BCDA office must be observed; and
- Observers/representatives who show signs of COVID-19 related symptoms such as cough, flu, fever, high body temperature, and sneezing are advised not to proceed to the BCDA Office since they will not be allowed to enter the BCDA premises.
