Procurement of Tarelco II Services in the Energization of New Clark City (NCC) Toll Plaza

RESOLUTION NO. BG-TSET-2022-01

WHEREAS, the Bases Conversion and Development Authority (BCDA), through its Strategic Projects Management Division (SPMD), intends to procure the Services of Tarlac II Electric Cooperative ("TARELCO II") for the Energization of the New Clark City (NCC) Toll Plaza (the "Project") through Direct Contracting pursuant to Section 50 of Article XVI of Republic Act (RA.) No. 9184 and Annex H, V (A) of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (RIRR) of RA. No. 9184;

WHEREAS, on 27 September 2022, the SPMD has secured the approval of the BCDA President and CEO to procure the aforementioned services;

WHEREAS, once the NCC Toll Plaza located at Virgen Delos Remedios, Bamban, Tarlac is energized, the public can start utilizing the New Clark City-Subic-Clark-Tarlac Expressway (NCC-SCTEX) Access Road constructed by BCDA, which will significantly reduce the travel time from SCTEX to NCC;

WHEREAS, TARELCO II is the only distribution utility that is allowed to operate within the areas of Concepcion and Capas where the NCC Toll Plaza is located;

WHEREAS, since TARELCO II is the only distribution utility that is allowed to operate within the areas of Concepcion and Capas, Tarlac, where the NCC Toll Plaza is located, the Services of TARELCO II for the Energization of the NCC Toll Plaza can be procured through Direct Contracting pursuant to Section 50 (b) and (c) of RA 9184 and Annex H, V (A) of the 2016 RIRR of RA 9184, which states that:

"Sec. 50. Direct Contracting. - Direct Contracting may be resorted to only in any of the following conditions:

XXX

- b) When the procurement of critical components from a specific supplier is a condition precedent to hold a contractor to guarantee its project performance, in accordance with the provisions of its contract; or
- c) Those sold by an exclusive dealer or manufacturer which does not have sub-dealers selling at lower prices and for which no suitable substitute can be obtained at more advantageous terms to the GoP.

WHEREAS, on 21 November 2022, the BAC-G conducted a Pre-Procurement Conference for the Energization of the NCC Toll Plaza wherein the the documentary requirements and technical specifications of the project were discussed;

WHEREAS, on 12 December 2022, the BAC-G requested for a quotation from TARELCO II for the procurement of its Services for the Energization of the NCC Toll Plaza;





WHEREAS, on 16 December 2022, TARELCO II sent a quotation for its Services in the total amount of Pesos: Three Million Eight Hundred Fifty-Nine Thousand One Hundred Twenty-Three and 26/100 (Php 3,859,123.26), inclusive of VAT and all applicable taxes;

NOW, THEREFORE, We, the Members of the Bids and Awards Committee for Goods, hereby **RESOLVE**, as it is hereby **RESOLVED**, to recommend the following:

- To procure the Services of Tarlac Electric Cooperative II (TARELCO II) for the Energization of the New Clark City (NCC) Toll Plaza through Direct Contracting pursuant to Section 50, Article XVI of Republic Act No. 9184 and Annex H, V (A) of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of RA 9184;
- To award the Contract to Tarlac Electric Cooperative II (TARELCO II) in the amount of Pesos: Three Million Eight Hundred Fifty-Nine Thousand One Hundred Twenty-Three and 26/100 (Php 3,859,123.26), inclusive of VAT and all applicable taxes and fees;
- To issue the corresponding Notice of Award to Tarlac Electric Cooperative II (TARELCO II);
 and
- 4. To direct the Strategic Projects Management Division (SPMD), as the end-user unit, to furnish the BAC-G with copies of the duly conformed Notice of Award, Notice to Proceed, and signed agreement/contract/Purchase Order.
