RESOLUTION NO. BG-OASE-2022-01

The **BASES CONVERSION AND DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY (BCDA)**, through the General Appropriations Act FY 2021 (validity extended pursuant to Republic Act No. 11640) has bid out the **Rebidding for the Supply, Delivery and Installation of Office and School Equipment for the National Academy of Sports (NAS) – Phase 1 at New Clark City** with an Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) of **Three Million Eight Hundred Twenty Two Thousand Five Hundred Pesos and 00/100 (PhP3,822,500.00)**, inclusive of all applicable taxes and fees;

WHEREAS, the Bids and Awards Committee for Goods (**BAC-G**), through its Secretariat, advertised/posted the Invitation to Bid including the bidding documents on 02 July 2022 in the following:

- a. DBM Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS);
- b. BCDA Website; and
- c. In a conspicuous place reserved for the purpose in the premises of BCDA.

WHEREAS, BAC-G conducted the Pre-bid Conference on 12 July 2022 which was attended by the following prospective bidders:

- a. Jozeth Trading;
- b. Philippine Vision Group (PVG) Inc.;
- c. Aurora Philippines;
- d. One Commerce Inc.; and
- e. Pro Event

WHEREAS, BAC-G issued Bid Bulletin No. BAC-G-OSE-2022-01 dated 26 July 2022 clarifying queries raised by the prospective bidders during the pre-bid conference and subsequently, via e-mail.

WHEREAS, in response to said advertisements, two (w) bidders, Jozeth Trading and Pro Event submitted their bids before the deadline on 02 August 2022;

WHEREAS, during the Opening of Bids on 02 August 2022 at 10:00 AM, BAC-G received and opened the bids of the following bidders and noted the following observation:

1. Jozeth Trading	Passed	Passed
2. Pro Event	Passed	Passed

WHEREAS, the two (2) bidders, Jozeth Trading and Pro Event were declared eligible during the Opening of Bids. Thus, the financial proposals of the three bidders were opened, as shown in the table below:

WHEREAS, in view of the results of the Detailed Evaluation of Bids on 04 August 2022, the BAC-G declared the bid of **Jozeth Trading** as ineligible for the following reasons:

WHEREAS, in the 08 August 2022 letter to **Jozeth Trading** the BAC-G informed them of their ineligibility to proceed with the bidding;

WHEREAS, the BAC-G recommended that Pro Event undergo a post qualification, being the lowest calculated bidder, on 10-22 August 2022, pursuant to Section 34 of Rule X – Post-Qualification of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (RIRR) of the Republic Act No. 9184;

WHEREAS, BAC-G deliberated the results of the post-qualification and found that Pro Event is eligible, legally, technically, and financially capable to undertake the project;

NOW, THEREFORE, We, the members of the Bids and Awards Committee for Goods, hereby **RESOLVE**, as it is hereby **RESOLVED**:

1. To declare **Pro Event** as the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bidder (LCRB) for the **Rebidding for the Supply, Delivery and Installation of Office and School Equipment for the National Academy of Sports (NAS) – Phase 1 at New Clark City**;
2. To award the contract for the **Rebidding for the Supply, Delivery and Installation of Office and School Equipment for the National Academy of Sports (NAS) – Phase 1 at New Clark City** to **Pro Event** in the amount of **Three Million Six Hundred Thirty-Four Thousand One Hundred Seventy-Two Pesos and 00/100 (Php3,634,172.00)**, inclusive of VAT and all applicable taxes and fees; and
3. To direct the Special Projects Management Department (SPMD), being the end-user unit, to submit to the BAC-G the duly conformed Notice of Award, Notice to Proceed, and the duly executed agreement/contract during the prescribed period.
