BIDDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF AIRPORT-NCC ACCESS ROAD (PHASE 1) BID BULLETIN NO. 3

This Bid Bulletin clarifies written queries received from prospective bidders from May 21, 2018 to May 29, 2018, and other matters relative to the Bidding for the Construction of Airport-NCC Access Road (Phase 1).

1. Queries/Questions by Prospective Bidders

	Issues Raised	Clarifications
1.	Whether the SLCC of an Affiliate of a member of a Consortium or Joint Venture partner is acceptable.	In cases of Joint Venture or Consortium, the submitted Single Largest Completed Contract (SLCC) should be from a member of the JV or Consortium.
2.	Whether a single contract with the scope of two (2) or more bridges is acceptable for SLCC.	Yes, the SLCC or Single Largest Completed Contract may contain the scope of the construction of two or more bridges, provided that these are in one single contract.
3.	On BDS item no. 11, whether the documents of a foreign bidder should be authenticated by the foreign embassy of their Company's country of registration which is located in the Philippines, or by the Philippine embassy in their company's country of registration.	The documents of the Foreign Bidder in a JV/Consortium should be duly authenticated by the Philippine Embassy located in the country where the Foreign Bidder is duly registered.
4.	Whether the Bid Securing Declaration only, i.e. without an accompanying cash, bank-draft or surety bond will satisfy the requirement for Bid Security in BDS item 12(b)(i).	Yes, a notarized Bid Securing Declaration alone signed by the authorized representative of the bidder or JV/Consortium can be submitted as Bid Security pursuant to Instructions to Bidders 12(b)(i).
5.	On Bid Security, whether each member of a Consortium can submit separate Bid Bonds amounting to their share in percentage.	Yes, provided that, it is in the prescribed form, amount, and validity period. Alternatively, bidders may execute a duly notarized Bid Securing Declaration instead of the Bid Bond. The notarized Bid Securing Declaration must, however, be signed by the authorized representative of the bidder or the JV/Consortium.

	Supplier of Equipment. However, being a foreign contractor it is prohibited under the law to enter into JV with domestic contractor specifically for projects funded through GAA unless the	There is no prohibition in RA 9184 and its Revised IRR for a foreign contractor to enter into a JV/Consortium with a local contractor for projects funded through the GAA.

Further, Sec. 23.4.2.3 of the Revised IRR states that the persons/entities enumerated in Sec. 23.4.2.1 may participate in competitive bidding if he/it has been issued a license by the PCAB to engage or act as a contractor. For JV/Consortium or foreign contractors, a special license from PCAB is required pursuant to RA4566.
9.	Bid Bulletin No. 2 states the Bid Submission date is 14 June 2018 12:00nn, while the PhilGEPS shows a Closing date shows 11 July 2018 10:00AM, which date will be followed?	The PhilGEPS closing date is the last day in which the Posting of this Bidding shall be available for viewing. The deadline for submission of bids is 14 June 2018, 12:00nn.
10.	Is the Contractor allowed to apply Value Engineering to this project?	Value engineering is not applicable on this project.
11.	Does BCDA have a Memorandum of Agreement with DBP or Landbank to support the contractor in financing the project without requirement collateral?	BCDA does not have any agreement with any bank regarding the grant of financial support to prospective contractors. However, BCDA can endorse the contractors who are interested to participate in the project to DBP.

	for bikeway lane is 0.75m which is stated in the BOQ, is this the correct thickness or must it be 0.075m or / 75mm thick?	Paving is 0.075m or 75mm.
13.	Based on the payment term, the contractor shall be paid through a milestone payment or will be upon completion of each phase. In this regard, we would like to clarify if the cost of money is input in the Approved Budget of Contract, because as a contractor, we need bank financing schemes to run this project.	The Approved Budget of the Contract (ABC) is inclusive of all costs, taxes, charges, cost of money, etc.
14.	Please provide existing Geotechnical reports for this project.	The Geotechnical Investigation Report may be downloaded in the BCDA website www.bcda.gov.ph
15.	Please provide existing ECC.	The ECC may be downloaded in the BCDA website www.bcda.gov.ph
16.	Request for boring log at Bridge 5 and Bridge 6, along Sta 1+114.00 to Sta 1+1500 and Sta 16+000.00 to Sta 19+826.824	Please refer to Geotechnical Investigation Report available for download in the BCDA website www.bcda.gov.ph
17.	Our project experience was JV, and we are also the civil subcontractor of our partner. Can we use the subcontract amount in addition to our principal share to be able for us to qualify?	It should only be in a single contract and provided that the shares in the JV as well as in the subcontract can be shown or proven in documents/agreements which are submitted as part of the Bid and can be verified by BCDA.
18.	Please confirm that there is no provision for metal deck for Sacobia bridge deck slab. (Drawing Reference: P25B-12)	No need for a metal deck.
19.	Reference BOQ 403 (10, 11, and 12) Kindly provide us detail drawing showing sizes, dimensions, etc. for Block Sockets/Crosshead adjustable anchorage, Open spelter shackles, bolt type shackles.	Wire rope connection details are shown in DWG P2SB-33. These are schematic and can be modified by the contractor subject to the approval of the Designer. The connections must be compatible with the wire rope (35mm) capacity with a breaking strength of 1770 MPa.

20. Can the Contractor's personnel to be assigned to the Contract to be bid (e.g., Project Manager, Project Engineers, Material Engineers, and Foremen) be of Foreign Nationality? We suggest that this be allowed through submission of certification/verification from PRC, or proof of application, with the personnel's equivalent license issued by their respective government entity.	Yes, provided that, foreign personnel comply with the regulations of the Professional Regulation Commission (PRC) and other government agencies. The required permits from government agencies shall be submitted as part of the bid.
21. If the bidder is a consortium or JV, is it allowable that the Bid Security is issued to one member, or that all will submit counter-securities, rather than the incorporated Consortium or JV?	Notarized Bid Securing Declaration can be signed by one Consortium/JV member authorized by the Consortium/JV.
22. Request to extend bid submission date to 28 June 2018, for us to give a reasonable and competitive bid price.	We cannot extend the Bid Submission Date any more, as it was already extended from June 1 to June 14, 2018.
23. Please clarify which paint system (System 1,2,3,4, or 5) to use for BOQ Item 403(6) – Structural Steel, Painting Works, and specification Section 403.3.23 in Part F – Bridge Construction document	System 2.

All provisions, conditions and statements in the bidding documents inconsistent with this Bid Bulletin are either modified or rendered ineffective, as the case may be.
