

Procurement of Appraisal Service for the Valuation of Various BCDA Properties

BID BULLETIN NO. 3

This Bid Bulletin clarifies the queries that were raised during the Pre-bid Conference on 05 June 2023 at 02:00 PM and queries sent through e-mail by prospective bidders, as well as other matters relative to the **Procurement of Appraisal Service for the Valuation of Various BCDA Properties**;

A. GENERAL INQUIRIES

1.	If Bidders were to opt to submit proposals for all 3 lots, does it mean that Bidders will have to submit the eligibility requirements for each lot?	Bidders who will opt to submit bids for more than 1 Lot, shall only have to submit 1 set of eligibility/bidding documents but will have to submit a separate Financial Proposal for each of the Lots they are bidding for.
2.	What can the Bidder submit to show proof that the Licensed Appraiser is in the process of renewing his/her PRC license?	A Bidder can submit a copy of the application form and official receipt showing the application for renewal of the PRC license.
3.	In the delivery schedule for the Navy Officers Village property, Colliers requested to extend the submission of the draft appraisal report from 15 calendar days to 25 calendar days considering that the appraisal required an as-is-where-is valuation as well as an appraisal as-if-developed which would require a careful review of the MDP and utilization of different appraisal approaches to come up with a proper valuation.	of ocular inspection, while the draft appraisal report for the as-if-developed portion of the

Cal-Fil requested that BCDA provide all necessary documentation, especially titles, tax declarations, plans, agreements, and all other information which the Appraiser would need to take into consideration in valuing the property. 8.	What is the scope of works of the lots?	The Scope of Work for Lots 1, 2 and 3 shall be the same.
9.	I would like to request BCDA to be specific on the description of light poles. Since your preference is the market comparison approach, please be advised that the more detailed information on the particular property to be appraised, the more we can resort to a market comparison approach.	BCDA shall endeavor to provide all the necessary documents/information upon request of the prospective bidder and depending on availability.
10.	On the day of ocular inspection will there be a guide to assist the Appraisers during inspection?	Yes, BCDA will accompany the Appraisers/Bidders during the ocular inspection of the properties and will entertain questions during the inspection.
11.	Why do you have a requirement for a female appraiser?	This is in support of the Gender and Development Program of the government
12.	Will the counting of calendar/working days start upon the submission of documents? Or best together with NTP?	The schedule for the ocular inspection, the submission of draft, revised and final reports are indicated in the Schedule of Requirements as included in the Bid Documents
