**THREE (3) YEAR CONTRACT FOR SECURITY SERVICES FOR
AOR I – BCDA CORPORATE CENTER AND BCDA FACILITIES, PDS**

RESOLUTION NO. BG 2018-014

WHEREAS, the BASES CONVERSION AND DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY (BCDA) has put on bid a **THREE (3) YEAR CONTRACT FOR SECURITY SERVICES FOR AOR I – BCDA CORPORATE CENTER AND BCDA FACILITIES, PDS** with an Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) of **Eleven Million Two Hundred Twenty Thousand Two Hundred Twenty-Eight Pesos (Php11,220,228.00)**, inclusive of all applicable taxes and fees;

WHEREAS, the BAC-G, through its Secretariat, advertised the Invitation to Bid on 27 April 2018 in the following:

- a. DBM Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS);
- b. BCDA Website; and
- c. In a conspicuous place reserved for the purpose in the premises of BCDA.

WHEREAS, in response to said advertisements, three (3) security agencies bought the bid documents, *to wit*:

- a. Hackett Security Agency;
- b. Catalina Security Agency; and
- c. Aremos Security and Investigation Agency.

WHEREAS, on 15 May 2018, the scheduled Opening of Bids (both Eligibility and Financial Proposals), the BAC-G received three (3) proposals from the above-stated agencies;

WHEREAS, after a thorough evaluation of the submitted eligibility documents, all three (3) bidders were found eligible having passed the set requirements.

WHEREAS, in line with the submitted financial proposals of the above-stated bidders, the tabulation below summarizes the financial bid “As Read”:

WHEREAS, the Technical Working Group (TWG) finds that Hackett Security Agency submitted the Lowest Calculated Bid subject to further Detailed Bid Evaluation;

WHEREAS, on the evaluation of each of the bidders' financial bid, two factors were considered: first, on the completeness of the bid and second, its arithmetical correction. After carefully reviewing and evaluating bidders' proposal, the TWG found that Catalina Security Agency and Aremos Security and Investigation Agency submitted bids that are compliant with all the requirements and conditions as specified in the Bidding Documents.

WHEREAS, TWG finds Hackett Security Agency's bid cannot be equated to Lowest Calculated Bid since it was non-compliant with the form prescribed by the Philippine Association of Detective and Protective Agency Operators (PADPAO) Wage Order No. NCR-21 and BCDA Financial Bid Form: Bid Price and Derivation of Price; (*please refer to Annex B*);

WHEREAS, the tabulation below summarizes the Computation prepared by the TWG relating to the bidders' cost distribution pursuant to the prescribed PADPAO form/computation:

WHEREAS, on 22 May 2018, TWG conducted a post-qualification evaluation to determine whether the two (2) eligible bidders - Catalina Security Agency and Aremos Security & Investigation Agency comply with and are responsive to all the requirements and conditions specified in the bidding documents for the Procurement of Security Services for AOR 1 - BCDA Corporate Center and BCDA Facilities, PDS. *The Post-Qualification Report is hereby attached as Annex C*;

WHEREAS, in its letter dated 29 May 2018, the BAC-G notified and invited the two (2) bidders to a tie-breaking process on 01 June 2018 at 2:00PM;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 3.3 of Appendix 11 of the Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9184, the BAC-G requested Catalina Security Agency and Aremos Security & Investigation Agency to suggest and agree to a non-discretionary/non-discriminatory tie-breaking method that is based on pure luck or chance;

WHEREAS, the two (2) eligible bidders agreed, among others, on the use of "toss-coin"/best of five as the method to break the tie; *The Tie-Breaking Form is hereby attached as Annex D*;

WHEREAS, after the third toss, Catalina Security Agency obtained three (3) "Head" sides thereby declaring it as winner of the tie-breaking process;

NOW, THEREFORE, we, the Members of the Bids and Awards Committee for Goods, hereby **RESOLVE** as it is hereby **RESOLVED** to recommend the following:

1. To declare **CATALINA SECURITY AGENCY** as the bidder with the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bid for the **THREE (3) YEARS CONTRACT FOR SECURITY SERVICES FOR AOR I – BCDA CORPORATE CENTER AND BCDA FACILITIES, PDS**;

2. To award the Contract to **CATALINA SECURITY AGENCY** in the amount of **Ten Million Eight Hundred Thirty-Two Thousand Four Hundred Twenty-Five Pesos and 53/100 (Php10,832,425.53)** inclusive of all applicable taxes and fees;
3. To issue the Notice of Award to **CATALINA SECURITY AGENCY** (Copy Attached); and
4. To direct the Security Services Unit, being the end-user unit, to furnish the BAC-G copies of the duly conformed Notice of Award, Notice to Proceed and the duly executed agreement/contract.
