BID BULLETIN NO. 6

TO ALL PROSPECTIVE PRIVATE SECTOR PARTICIPANTS:

Capitalised terms used and not otherwise defined in this Bid Bulletin No. 6 shall have the meaning given to them in the Instructions to Private Sector Participants: Volume 1 - Eligibility Documents issued by the Joint Venture Selection Committee of the Bases Conversion and Development Authority on 16 May 2018, as amended, for the Competitive Selection for the Joint Venture Development of the Electric Power Distribution System in New Clark City.

This Bid Bulletin No. 6 is being issued to clarify the Invitation Documents, as follows:

1. *Satisfaction of Technical Capability Requirements as Project Owner*

It is reconfirmed that, if the entities (including their Affiliates) nominated to fulfill any of the Technical Capability Requirements intends to satisfy such requirement with projects undertaken in its capacity as a project owner, then, such entity has undertaken the project as project owner and not as contractor. Projects may still be considered eligible even if portions of the project were outsourced provided that the project owner undertook on its own the eligible projects.

2. *Construction and Design Experience Requirements – Applicable voltage range*

It is clarified that the voltage range set out in Table 1-A (*Design Experience Requirement*) and Table 1-B (*Construction Experience Requirement*) of Section 3.2.1 of IPSP: Volume 1 – Eligibility Documents shall be read as including such other voltage that is within the standard voltage for power distribution systems where the project / project component operates.

Additionally, attached as **ANNEX A** is the Eligibility Documents Checklist, which provides a general guide for prospective PSPs in the completion and submission of the Eligibility Documents. The Eligibility Documents Checklist is being provided for the sole purpose of reference and convenience of prospective PSPs. No reliance can be made on said checklist and its contents and, in accordance with Section 2.5 of IPSP: Volume 1 – Eligibility Documents, its issuance does not relieve prospective PSPs of their responsibility to examine all the Invitation Documents including all instructions, forms, schedules and terms. In the event of a conflict or discrepancy between the Eligibility Documents Checklist and the Invitation Documents, the latter shall prevail. No terms of the IPSP: Volume 1 – Eligibility Documents are modified by the Eligibility Documents Checklist.

Prospective PSPs are reminded that the deadline for submission of queries, comments, and clarifications in relation to the Invitation Documents as provided in Section 2.7 of the IPSP: Volume 1 – Eligibility Documents, as amended, is 12:00 p.m. on 8 June 2018, and has thus lapsed.

In accordance with Section 2.3 of the IPSP: Volume 1 – Eligibility Documents, this Bid Bulletin No. 6 is issued to all parties who purchased the IPSP: Volume 1 – Forms and Annexures.

If any one of the provisions of this Bid Bulletin No. 6 is held invalid, illegal or unenforceable, the validity, legality or enforceability of the remaining provisions will not be affected thereby.
