TERMS OF REFERENCE

Lease of High-end Network Cameras and HD Surveillance, Recording and Monitoring System for the Bases Conversion and Development Authority

I. BACKGROUND

The BCDA was created under RA 7227, as amended, primarily to carry out the declared policies of the Government of the Republic of the Philippines to accelerate the sound and balanced conversion of the former US military bases and Metro Manila camps into alternative productive civilian uses and premier centers of economic growth in partnership with the private sector with integrity, excellence and stewardship of government resources.

The BCDA is a major force in creating and expanding economic opportunities in the Philippines through its establishment of integrated development areas, dynamic business centers and vibrant communities. BCDA's areas of jurisdiction require the construction of Information and Communications Technology (ICT) infrastructure to make it more viable. Section 5(c) of RA 7227, as amended, has vested BCDA with the power to enter into, make, perform and carry out contracts of every class and kind and description which are necessary or incidental to the realization of its purposes with any public or private enterprise.

The lease of High-end Network Cameras and HD Surveillance, Recording and Monitoring System Project utilizing Fiber Optic Network System will be procured and installed within the designated areas of Clark International Airport (CIA) to boost up the security and monitoring in the airport during the ASEAN Summit to be held in November 2017.

The proposed system must meet up to expectations and accepted reliability, utilizing modern, functional user-friendly, and reliable – upgradeable that can be expanded for future additional requirements.

II. SCOPE AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE BIDDER/SUPPLIER

- c. Require installation of High-end Video Management System and Monitoring System. The monitoring must be capable of facial recognition, video matrix, video stitching, video wall and projecting other media devices such as Desktop and/or Laptop. It must support Local Clients, Remote Clients, Mobile Clients and Web Browsers. Third-party applications such as post analytics must be capable to integrate in the system.
- 2. The Bidder/Supplier is expected to Supply, Deliver and Install the following in the Command Center the following:

a. Network Storage

Embedded Network Video Recorder (NVR) and Network Attached Storage including its software, accessories and peripherals. The NVR shall act as a recorder and process/facilitate remote viewing, playback and backup. Recording retention must be able to do up to 30 days 24/7 for the NVR in the Command Center's Server room.

b. Monitoring Center

This viewing station shall be installed at the Command Center composed of twelve (12) wall mounted LFD Monitor, Video Wall System, four (4) sub monitoring workstations with dual monitor with tables and chairs, network keyboard to push video to the monitors, conference tables and chairs and server room where data cabinets is located with the NVR, UPS, Network Switch, and Video Matrix Device.

DIZON, as evidenced by BCDA Board Resolution No. 2017-03 -062, hereto attached as Annex "B" and made as an integral part hereof, hereafter referred to as "BCDA";

Each may be referred to as "PARTY" and collectively as "PARTIES".

ANTECEDENTS

BCDA was created under Republic Act (R.A.) No. 7227, as amended, primarily to carry out the declared policies of the Government of the Republic of the Philippines to accelerate the sound and balanced conversion of the former US military bases and Metro Manila camps into alternative productive civilian uses and premier centers of economic growth in partnership with the private sector with integrity, excellence and stewardship of government resources.

Proclamation No. 163 was issued, creating the Clark Special Economic Zone (CSEZ) consisting of parcels of land formerly occupied by the Clark military reservation and its contiguous extensions, and transferring said lands to the **BCDA**. Executive Order No. 174 was then issued designating the CESZ as the site for the Clark International Airport (CIA).

The Republic of the Philippines has been chosen to host the 31st ASEAN Summit in November 2017, and **BCDA**, being the governing body of the CSEZ and one of the major forces of the government in creating and expanding economic opportunities in the Philippines, is tasked to undertake various projects in the CSEZ for the holding of the summit.

To help the State ensure the safety of the delegates of the 31st ASEAN Summit, there is a need to enhance the Security and Monitoring System (System) of the CIA. ARTICLE I PROJECT

The Project refers to the supply, delivery and installation of High-end Network Cameras and HD Surveillance, Recording and Monitoring System utilizing Fiber Optic Network System within the identified areas of the Clark International Airport, Clark, Pampanga.

ARTICLE II FACILITIES, EQUIPMENT AND SPECIFICATIONS

- 2.1 The **LESSOR** shall provide the **BCDA** with the facilities, equipment and services specified in **Annex "H"** which shall form as integral part of this Agreement.
- 2.2 To conform to the security and monitoring requirements of the CIA, the System must be modern, functional, user-friendly, reliable and upgradeable or that can be expanded for future additional requirements.

ARTICLE III CONTRACT DOCUMENTS

3.1 The following documents shall be made integral parts of this Agreement, as fully as if the contents of the said documents were reproduced, incorporated and set forth herein, and shall govern and control in full force and effect the rights and obligations of the PARTIES, except as otherwise modified by the terms and conditions of this Agreement, or by mutual agreement of both PARTIES in writing:

- 3.2 All Contract Documents are and shall remain the properties of **BCDA**.
- 3.3 The Contract Documents shall be complementary to each other and what is called or prescribed by one shall be considered as if called for or prescribed by all. In case of any discrepancy between any of the Contract Documents or any defective description, error, omission or ambiguity in any of the Contract Documents, the LESSOR shall, within 30 days, submit the matter in writing to BCDA. BCDA shall, within a reasonable time, make a decision thereon in writing. Such decision by BCDA shall be final and binding upon the LESSOR which shall proceed with the work strictly in accordance with such decision.

- 3.3 The **BCDA** shall have the right to furnish the **LESSOR** during the progress of the work such additional drawings, instructions and documents as **BCDA** may deem necessary for the proper accomplishment of the work. All such additional drawings, instructions and documents, as well as any decision made by **BCDA** shall form integral parts of this Agreement.
- 3.4 In case of any irreconcilable conflict between this Agreement and the provisions of any of the Contract Documents, the former shall prevail.

ARTICLE IV PROJECT MILESTONES AND SCHEDULE

4.1 Completion Period

The LESSOR shall complete the Project, to BCDA's satisfaction, as follows:

- 4.1.1 Supply, delivery, installation, testing, commissioning and operation of the Project shall be within thirty-eight (38) days upon receipt of the Notice to Proceed.
- 4.1.2 Operation and maintenance of the Command Center shall be for six (6) months upon issuance of the Provisional Acceptance Certificate.

4.3 Extension of Completion Period

- 4.3.1 No extension of time shall be granted to the LESSOR due to ordinary unfavorable weather conditions, non-availability of equipment or materials to be furnished thereby, labor problems and such causes for which BCDA is not directly responsible. Extension of time may only be granted for force majeure or fortuitous events due to acts of nature; provided that, the extension only granted upon favorable recommendation of BCDA's personnel assigned to the Project after due notice has been given to BCDA.
- 4.3.2 Force majeure or fortuitous events, for purposes of this Agreement, shall be interpreted to mean an event which parties could not have foreseen or which though foreseen, is inevitable or beyond the control of the parties. It shall include acts of God, such as fire, storms, floods, earthquakes, fire or other cataclysmic events, or acts of man, such as war, acts of public enemies, or other occurences that are beyond the control of the PARTIES.

4.4 Liquidated Damages

4.4.1 TIME IS OF THE ESSENCE OF THIS AGREEMENT. The Project must be completed according to specifications and/or technical requirements and within the specified timetable. Should the LESSOR refuse or fail to satisfactorily complete the work or perform the services within the time specified under this Agreement, inclusive of allowable extension, if any, BCDA shall, without prejudice to other remedies under this Agreement and under the applicable laws, deduct from the Contract Price, as liquidated damages, the rate of ½ of 1% of the cost of the unperformed portion for every day of delay until actual performance.

4.4.2 BCDA may impose additional liquidated damages as it may deem necessary; provided that, the same shall not exceed the maximum amount allowed under the law, which is 10% of the Contract Price. BCDA may cancel this Agreement and forfeit the performance bond should the penalty reach 10% of the Contract Price without prejudice to other course of action of remedies available to it.

4.5 Provisional and Final Acceptance

4.5.1 Provisional Acceptance

After the LESSOR completed the supply, delivery and installation of the Project, BCDA shall issue Provisional Acceptance Certificate.

4.5.2 Final Acceptance

After the completion of the 6-month lease period and compliance with all the requirements provided in this Agreement, BCDA shall issue the Final Acceptance Certificate which shall entitle the LESSOR to the payment of the final billing.

ARTICLE VI MANNER OF PAYMENT

6.1 Payment Terms and Conditions

In consideration of the lease under this Agreement, payment to the **LESSOR** shall be made in the following manner:

- a. Fifteen percent (15%) of the Total Contract Price shall be paid upon signing of this Agreement and submission by the LESSOR of an irrevocable letter of credit or bank guarantee acceptable to BCDA;
- Fifty percent (50%) of the Total Contract Price upon completion of the installation and rectification of punch-listed items by the LESSOR and the issuance of the provisional Acceptance Certificate by BCDA;

- c. Fifteen percent (15%) of the Total Contract Price upon completion of the three-month lease period;

ARTICLE VII RESPONSIBILITIES

The layout design and installation of the System shall conform with generally accepted engineering, usage, and safety standards for electronic industry as applicable to airports.
- 7.2 **LESSOR** shall be solely responsible for sourcing, ordering, importation, release, and transport to the CIA of all components of the System and/or Project.
- 7.3 **LESSOR** shall provide the insurance of the High-end Cameras and HD Surveillance System, Recording and Monitoring System at no cost to **BCDA**.
- 7.4 **BCDA** shall provide all the available documents including plans and information related to the Project that may be needed by the LESSOR in pursuing the tasks under this Agreement.
- 7.5 **BCDA** shall provide the following:
 - 7.4.1 light posts for the installation of the cameras with source power of at least 20m; and
 - 7.4.2 staging area of the Project.

ARTICLE VIII BONDS

8.1 **Performance Security**

Within ten (10) days from the LESSOR's receipt of the Notice of Award from BCDA, the LESSOR shall provide a Performance Security in favor of BCDA in the manner, amount and form specified below, which shall be valid until issuance of the Final Acceptance Certificate of the Project and which shall guarantee the faithful and complete performance by the LESSOR of its obligations and responsibilities under this Agreement.

ARTICLE IX OWNERSHIP AND RETURN OF EQUIPMENT

- 9.1 Beneficial and legal ownership over the equipment and other accessories attached to the installed System as provided by the **LESSOR** shall remain with the **LESSOR** from their installation at the CIA and until the termination of this Agreement.
- 9.2 **BCDA** shall not make any alteration on the equipment, nor shall **BCDA** sell, transfer, mortgage, rent or encumber the said equipment that will, in any way, prejudice the rights and interests of the **LESSOR**. The equipment shall remain the property of the **LESSOR** regardless of any claim or reason therefor, such as judgments, execution, provisions, attachment and provisional disposition of the equipment. In any event, the **BCDA** shall inform the **LESSOR** immediately of any attachment, levy, execution or similar lien over the equipment and the **BCDA** shall exercise due diligence and exert all efforts to protect the right of the **LESSOR** over the equipment.
- 9.3 Upon termination or cancellation of this Agreement, the equipment and other accessories attached to the installed System shall be returned to the **LESSOR** within a reasonable period as determined by the PARTIES.

ARTICLE X COMPENSATION IN CASE OF LOSS OR DAMAGE

10.1 At its sole expense, the LESSOR shall undertake all necessary repairs and maintenance of all facilities and equipment and shall hold the BCDA free from any liability whatsoever for damage to or deterioration of said facilities and equipment, wear and tear excepted which shall be compensated for and by the amount charged for depreciation under this Agreement; provided, however, the BCDA shall compensate the LESSOR for any loss of, or damage to, the equipment caused by or due to any willful act or fault or negligence of the BCDA, its representative, personnel, agent, or any person acting in its behalf, or any loss or damage resulting from or due to violation by the BCDA or its personnel of any term of this Agreement. 10.2 It shall be the duty of the BCDA to immediately inform the LESSOR of any breakdown, damage, or loss of equipment or accessories so that the LESSOR can immediately restore the full operation of the System for the mutual benefit of both parties.

ARTICLE XI MAINTENANCE SERVICE AND REPAIR

- 11.1 **BCDA** agrees to exercise due diligence and care in the use of the equipment and facilities that have been installed by the **LESSOR**. Any loss or damage to the equipment caused by the willful act or gross negligence shall be chargeable to the **BCDA** up to the actual replacement cost or repair of the same.
- 11.2 **BCDA** shall allow the authorized representatives of the **LESSOR** to have access to all related equipment for the purpose of complying with its contractual obligations for repair and maintenance under this Agreement. Regular maintenance and inspection shall be at reasonable hours of the day.
- 11.3 LESSOR shall provide a call center support and helpdesk for convenient and proper communication for the maintenance service and repair of the equipment or installed System.

ARTICLE XII REPLACEMENT UNIT

- 12.1 If in the judgment of the **BCDA**, the repeated breakdown of the equipment is prejudicial to its interest or when it is determined that the equipment problem is irreparable, the **BCDA** can immediately demand for a replacement unit of equal or superior model and capacity as the one being replaced. Further, **BCDA** shall have the option to terminate this Agreement without incurring any liability for the payment of rental and/or damages arising therefrom.
- 12.2 **LESSOR** shall provide replacement unit within 24 hours from BCDA's demand at no cost to the **BCDA**.

ARTICLE XIII RESTRICTION AND LIABILITIES

Both PARTIES shall not hold the other liable for failure to continue with or comply with their respective obligations under this Agreement for causes and/or circumstances beyond the control of the party who is to perform, such as fire, natural calamities, other events constituting *force majeure*, acts of God, restrictions imposed by government, other government acts and interventions, war, national emergencies, and strike affecting either party; provided, however, that if the strike affects the ability of the LESSOR to perform its repair and maintenance and obligations under this Agreement, this shall be contracted out at the expense or for the account of the LESSOR to a third party recommended by or acceptable to the LESSOR. Acceptance of a third-party service contractor shall not be unreasonably withheld by the BCDA.

ARTICLE XIV ASSIGNMENT OF RIGHTS

This Agreement is binding on both PARTIES and all the rights of the PARTIES shall not be assigned to others or third parties without prior written consent of the other PARTY. Such consent shall relieve the PARTIES from all responsibilities and liabilities for the work contemplated herein and for the due performance of all the terms and conditions of this Agreement. If the agreement is assigned or any of the equipment and facilities is/are sublet, the PARTIES shall exonerate, indemnify and save harmless the other PARTY from and against any and all loss, damages, liability or expenses arising or resulting therefrom.

ARTICLE XV CONFIDENTIALITY

During the term of this Agreement or any time thereafter, the PARTIES hereto shall not divulge, furnish or make accessible to anyone or use in any way confidential information acquired by reason of this Agreement relating to the operations of either PARTY.

ARTICLE XVII TERMINATION OR CANCELLATION OF AGREEMENT

- 17.2 Notwithstanding Article XVI hereof, either PARTY may, at any time and with prior 30-day notice to the other, terminate this Agreement under any of the following instances:
 - a. Violation of any provision of this Agreement;
 - b. Bankruptcy proceedings instituted against, appointment of a receiver for or change in ownership of either party; and,
 - c. Any other ground authorized by law.

ARTICLE XVIII EFFECTS OF TERMINATION

When the Agreement is terminated due to the fault of **BCDA**, any outstanding account shall be due and payable without need of any formal demand by the **LESSOR**. In case the termination is due to the **LESSOR**'s fault, the **LESSOR** shall be liable for whatever consequential damages incurred by BCDA without **BCDA**'s demand.

ARTICLE XIX ARBITRATION

Should any dispute arise between the **LESSOR** and the **BCDA**, no party may institute litigation until the matters in dispute are first referred to arbitration in accordance with the provisions of R.A. No. 9285.

ARTICLE XX VENUE, JUDICIAL RELIEF AND PENALTY

Should arbitration fail, or should both parties mutually agree to waive arbitration, only the proper courts of Taguig City shall have exclusive jurisdiction over any and all legal actions arising from the interpretation or enforcement of this Agreement.

ARTICLE XXI GENERAL PROVISIONS

- 21.1 **Amendments.** This Agreement shall not be considered as changed, modified, altered, waived or in any way amended, unless such changes, modification, waivers or amendments are made in writing, signed by both PARTIES and executed with the same formality as this Agreement.
- 21.2 **Separability.** If any provision of this Agreement is held invalid or contrary to law, the validity of the other provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

- 21.3 **Modification.** The PARTIES hereby agree to amend or modify any provision of this Agreement, which might be declared invalid or contrary to law, to conform to the subject and objective hereof.
- 21.4 **Non-Waiver.** No failure or delay on the part of a party to exercise any right, power or privilege hereunder, or to enforce at any time or for any period of time any provision hereof, shall be construed to be a waiver of such right, power privilege

ARTICLE XXII MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS

- 22.1 The PARTIES represent that they have the requisite power, authority, and capacity to enter into this Agreement and to perform their obligations and responsibilities according to the terms and conditions hereof.
