

BAC-C RESOLUTION NO. BC-2018-038

DECLARATION OF HIGHEST RATED AND RESPONSIVE BID (HRRB)

Consulting Services for Construction Management and Supervision (CMS) of the Airport (CIA) to New Clark City (NCC) Access Road

WHEREAS, on May 21, 2018, BCDA advertised the Request for Expression of Interest (REI) for the said consulting services in the BCDA website, PhilGEPS website and in a conspicuous place in the premises of BCDA continuously for seven (7) calendar days;

WHEREAS, the consulting services has an Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) amounting to Pesos: One Hundred Seventeen Million and 00/100 Pesos (PhP 117,000,000.00), inclusive of all applicable taxes, fees and other charges, to be completed within 18 months for the construction phase and three (3) months for the post construction / documentation phase;

WHEREAS, the evaluation procedure adopted for the procurement was the Quality Cost Based Evaluation (QCBE) System, wherein the technical and financial proposals were given numerical weights equivalent to 85% and 15%, respectively. Only the financial proposals of bidders who met the minimum technical score of 70% were opened;

WHEREAS, the Bids and Awards Committee for Consulting Services (BAC-C) issued Resolution No. BC-2018-032 dated September 6, 2018, wherein the Joint Venture of Filipinas Dravo Corporation and Pertconsult International (Joint Venture) was declared as the bidder with the Highest Rated Bid (HRB) for the Consulting Services for the CMS of the CIA to NCC Access Road. Likewise, the said resolution resolved to recommend the approval to proceed with the negotiations with the Joint Venture;

WHEREAS, on September 20, 2018, negotiation with the HRB was conducted pursuant to Section 33.2.5 of the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of RA 9184;

WHEREAS, after the conduct of successful negotiation, the BAC-C instructed the Technical Working Group (TWG) to conduct the post-qualification activities to verify, validate, and ascertain all statements made and documents submitted by the Joint Venture;

WHEREAS, on September 26, 27 and October 5, 2018, the TWG undertook the following post qualification activities:

 Conducted an ocular visit of the offices of the members of the Joint Venture. 5th floor, Aurora Milestone Building, 1045 Aurora Boulevard, Quezon City and 9th Floor, The Excelsior Building, 161 Roxas Boulevard Extension, Parañaque City for Filipinas Dravo Corporation and Pertconsult International, respectively;

- 2. Validated the original copies of Class A legal documents, documents in compliance with labor laws such as latest payment to SSS, PhilHealth, and Pag-ibig Fund, and supporting documents for completed and on-going projects of both members of the Joint Venture;
- Conducted one-on-one interviews with all nominated key personnel to ensure availability and commitment to render the required services under the Terms of Reference;
- 4. Verified positive feedback on the performance of services from their previous clients through phone calls.

NOW THEREFORE, after deliberation and premises considered, we, the members of the BAC-C hereby RESOLVE to recommend the approval of the following:

- 1. DECLARE the Joint Venture of Filipinas Dravo Corporation and Pertconsult International as the bidder with the Highest Rated and Responsive Bid (HRRB) for the Consulting Services for the CMS of the CIA to NCC Access Road;
- 2. AWARD the contract to the Joint Venture of Filipinas Dravo Corporation and Pertconsult International in the amount of Pesos: Eighty eight million nine hundred sixty-seven thousand two hundred (Php88,967,200), inclusive of all applicable taxes, fees and other charges to be completed within 18 months for the construction phase and three (3) months for the post construction / documentation phase;
- 3. DIRECT the end user to request for the issuance of the Certificate of Funds Availability (CFA) for the procurement prior to the award of the contract;
- 4. DIRECT the end user to submit to the BAC-C an evaluation of the performance of the consultant at the end of the contract; and
- 5. DIRECT the end user to furnish the BAC-C copies of the duly conformed Notice of Award, Notice to Proceed, as well as the executed contract, and all supporting documents pursuant to the procurement.
