

RE-BIDDING FOR THE SIX-MONTH LEASE OF HIGH-END NETWORK CAMERAS AND HIGH-DEFINITION (HD) SURVEILLANCE, RECORDING AND MONITORING SYSTEM

BID BULLETIN NO. CAM-RB2017-001

This Bid Bulletin clarifies the queries during the Pre-Bid Conference held last 16 August 2017, queries sent by the Prospective Bidders, and other matters relative to the **Re-Bidding of the Six-Month Lease of High-End Network Cameras and HD Surveillance, Recording and Monitoring System**. This Bid Bulletin likewise modifies or amends the items in the Bidding Documents.

1. Queries/Questions by Prospective Bidders

Issues Raised	Clarification/s
1. Whether the winning bidder shall be the one to secure the permits for the installation of cameras and installation of equipment in the Command Center.	The winning bidder is required to apply and secure the necessary permits and licenses with the assistance of BCDA/CIAC for the installation of cameras and equipment including the access pass for all its personnel.
2. Whether Joint Venture (JV) Partners are allowed to bill BCDA.	BCDA shall process the billings of the contractor upon submission of notarized copy of Certification indicating the authorized representative from the members of the Joint Venture, provided that required deliverables have been completed and accepted by BCDA and documentary requirements are complete.
3. On the Certification of 200 Network Cameras, whether the 3-year requirement can be changed into 5 years.	The bidder shall submit relevant documents or proof that it has installed an accumulated 200 network cameras within the last 5 years of its operation instead of 3 years as stated in the Terms of Reference.
4. Whether the requirement is Mini-Dome Type IP Camera or Dome Type IP Camera.	The requirement is MINI-DOME TYPE IP CAMERA instead of DOME TYPE IP CAMERA.
5. Whether the 34 units SFP Module is intended for the fiber connections because the number of SFP module does not tally with the number of Cameras which is 46.	BCDA requires 34 units 1000MB SFP Module since there are 6 cabinets that contain 3 cameras each (1 PTZ, 2 bullet cameras), and one PTZ camera for the remaining 28 cabinets, for the total of 34 cabinets installed in the project.

6. Query on 1000 MB SFP Module	Yes, Backhaul 1000 MB SFP is the minimum requirement. 100 MB can be considered only for remote interfacing. Minimum specifications were determined for possible future upgrades and additional connectivity use.
7. Query on Gigabit Fiber Switch	Yes, 4xCombo (10/100/1000 BASE-T or 100/1000 BASE-X) is the minimum requirement. Minimum specifications were determined for flexibility on redundancy interfaces for future connectivity use.
8. Who shall provide the Certification for the Certified CCTV Installer and CCTV Engineer?	The bidder must submit a Company Certification and/or Licensed Manufacturer Certificate to support the years of experience of the nominated personnel.
9. Which camera will have the License Plate Recognition, People Counting, and Facial Recognition and where will the location of the said cameras be?	<u>Airport Gates:</u> License Plate Recognition, People Counting and Facial Recognition <u>Airside Parking:</u> People Counting and Facial Recognition Location of the Cameras – see attached location map
10. Will man lifts be provided for the mounting of the cameras?	No, the bidder shall provide the man lifts
11. May we know the number of gates that CIAC have?	There 6 airport gates, Airport Gate Nos. 1, 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7.
12. What are the total numbers of cameras for License Plate Recognition, People Counting Interface, and Face Recognition?	License Plate Recognition – 12 bullets cameras People Counting Interface } 12 bullets cameras Face Recognition } 34 PTZ cameras
13. On Network Video Recorder, whether the 30 Frames per second can be changed to 15 Frames per second @ 2MP	The 30 frames per second at 1080p shall be retained. The corresponding server and storage capacity should be capable of handling said resolution during the lease period.
14. Where will the source of the data for facial recognition be coming from?	The data would be coming either from BCDA or the National Organizing Committee (NOC).
15. Whether the 47" size of LFD ultra-thin bezel is already fixed or can be higher.	The winning bidder may provide a higher specification or equivalent to what is required provided that it would fit in the given space. The Project Manager of the winning bidder must coordinate with the Engineers in the Command Center.

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16. **TECHNICAL MAINTENANCE AND SUPPORT STAFF**

The bidder shall provide the following personnel during the supply, delivery and installation of the project:

The bidder is also required to provide a Licensed Civil Engineer on-call during the implementation of the project at no cost to BCDA.

2. **Further/Other Clarifications from the BAC**

- a. A **Site Inspection** was conducted on August 17, 2017 in CIAC. The prospective bidders were requested during the Pre-Bid Conference to submit the full names of their representatives who will join the site inspection so that proper access pass could be prepared.
- b. The **Project Implementation Plan** shall be **submitted within 3 days** after the award of contract for BCDA’s approval instead of 10 days as indicated in the Terms of Reference.
- c. BCDA shall issue an access pass and shall provide a holding area for the technical staff of the winning bidders.
- d. The bidders must be registered with PhilGEPS under Platinum Membership, otherwise the bidders will be rated failed which shall result in declaring them as “ineligible”.
- e. The bid documents can be accessed from the PhilGEPS and BCDA Websites.
- f. The bid bulletin shall be posted in PhilGEPS and BCDA websites on **22 August 2017**. However, only those who purchased the bidding documents are entitled to directly receive a copy of the Bid Bulletin by email.
- g. The bidders have to purchase the bid documents before they are allowed to submit their bids. They can still purchase the document until the day of submission.



- h. The computation of the bid security shall be based on the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC).
- i. The bidders may submit a notarized Bid Securing Declaration in lieu of other forms of bid security. It is important to note, however, that although the Bid Securing Declaration does not require cash, its enforcement shall include automatic blacklisting and payment of certain fines in the event that the bidder violates any of the conditions set forth in the bidding documents.
- j. The bid should not be more than the ABC, otherwise the bidder will be disqualified.
- k. NFCC Computation should be based on the Audited Financial Statements for the year 2015 or 2016 whichever is available, using the computation provided in paragraph 5.5 of the Instruction to Bidders, and should be at least equivalent to the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC).
- l. The bidders are requested to use tabs in compiling their bid documents for quick and easy identification and verification.

3. Reminders from the BAC

- a. BCDA adheres to the "No-Contact Rule". All clarifications should be made in writing and addressed to the BAC-G Secretariat. **Deadline for Clarification is at 5pm on 18 August 2017.**
- b. Visiting or calling the members of the BAC, the TWG, the Secretariat or anyone working for BCDA is not allowed and will not be entertained.
- c. Dates, in the absence of any qualifications, are meant to be calendar days. Calendar days include Saturdays, Sundays and Holidays.
- d. **The deadline for the submission of bids for the Re-Bidding for the Six (6)-month Lease of High-End Network Cameras and HD Surveillance, Recording and Monitoring System is on August 29, 2017 at 1:00 PM** at the BCDA Central Receiving and Releasing Area (CRRRA) located at the 2nd Floor Bonifacio Technology Center, 31st St. cor. 2nd Avenue, Bonifacio Global City, Taguig City. The computer system clock at the CRRRA that is set to Philippine Standard Time (PhST) shall be used as reference in determining the time for the submission of bids. Hence, participating bidders are advised to synchronize their timepieces with the said computer system clock. **Late bids or those submitted after 1:00 PM of 29 August 2017 shall not be accepted.**
- e. Bidders may submit their eligibility documents a day before the deadline for submission to avoid the possibility of being late for submission.
- f. **Bid opening shall be on August 29, 2017 at 2:00 PM** at the BCDA Corporate Center, 2nd Floor Bonifacio Technology Center, 31st St. cor. 2nd Avenue, Bonifacio Global City, Taguig City. Bids will be opened in the presence of the Bidders.

However, the Bidders' attendance during the Opening of Bids is not compulsory but it is advised that bidders send their representative to assist the BAC and answer clarifications, if any.

- g. Each and every page of the Bid Form must be appropriately signed by the bidders or the bidder's authorized representative. The authorization should also be attached. Failure to do so shall be a ground for the rejection of the Bid.
- h. All licenses, permits and other required clearances should be valid at the time of the submission of bids, Post-Qualification evaluation, and signing of the contract
- i. The BAC expects the bidders to exercise due diligence in going through the bidding documents to be able to prepare their bids intelligently.
- j. The following documents are required to be NOTARIZED, which should be duly sworn to and include complete information on the PTR No., MCLE No., Authority or Commission Number, etc.
 - i. Omnibus Sworn Statement
 - ii. Bidder's Representative Authorization (as provided in Paragraph 2 of the Omnibus Sworn Statement)
 - iii. Bid Securing Declaration
- k. BCDA reserves the right to waive minor defects in forms and requirement as long as they do not affect the genuineness and authenticity of the documents submitted.
- l. BCDA reserves the right to accept or reject any bid, to annul the bidding process, and to reject all bids at any time prior to contract award, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders.

Please be reminded that all queries after the release of this Bid Bulletin will not be entertained.

All provisions, conditions and statements in the bidding documents inconsistent with this Bid Bulletin are either modified or rendered ineffective, as the case may be.
