Undertaking of Early Procurement Activities (EPA)**

I hereby certify that the **BASES CONVERSION AND DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY (BCDA)** has not successfully undertaken Early Procurement Activities (EPA) for at least fifty percent (50%) of the total value of eligible procurement projects provided in its Indicative Annual Procurement Plan (APP) in line with the National Expenditure Plan (NEP) for the Fiscal Year 2024, as shown below:

1. BCDA needs to secure budget advice/clearance from the Department of Budget Management (DBM) before commencing with the procurement process of Projects funded by the General Appropriation Act (GAA); and
2. BCDA GAA-funded projects are subject to an Infrastructure Development Program wherein the final specifications, scope of works or detailed engineering design, or Terms of Reference (TOR) are required to be examined and approved by the concerned government agencies affected by the projects, which ultimately affects the timeline for the procurement. More specifically explained, as follows:
