

1.	<p>Please provide a definition for:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 100,000 Billable end-points including mixed end-user base • Seven (7) Integrated Networks 	<p>Table 1-A, Section 3.2.4.1 of IPSP Volume 1 is revised to include the following definitions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • “Billable End-Points” refer to the <u>DTP end-user points that are connected or connectable to an Integrated Network.</u> • “Mixed End User Base” means <u>different customer market segments, e.g., a mix of business and residential.</u> <p>The minimum requirement for design of underground optical fiber multi-conduit network in Table 1-A, Section 3.2.4.1 of IPSP Volume 1 is further revised as follows to provide a clearer definition of ‘Integrated Network’:</p> <p>More than one hundred (100) kilometers of underground optical fiber multi-conduit network within seven (7) <u>passive Integrated Networks.</u></p> <p><u>An “Integrated Network” is defined as a multi-conduit network with multiple fiber routes/cables built to a common design that serves an identifiable, contiguous area aggregated back to a central network site/connection point with capability for interconnection to the equipment of more than one [1] DTP.</u></p> <p>An illustration is included below as an example.</p>

2.	<p>Under Design Experience Requirement (3.2.4.1) and Maintenance Experience Requirement (3.2.5.1.2), about an in-house experience, can a sworn statement from an Officer of a Telco company certifying that the company has 100k billable endpoints including mixed and user base satisfy the experience requirement, and Service level agreements with a record showing restoration of services/repair of outages within a maximum of eight (8) hours for 95% of the time for the prior consecutive five (5) years for (i) More than one hundred (100) kilometers of underground optical fiber multi-conduit network within seven (7) Integrated Networks AND (ii) 100,000 billable end-points?</p>	<p>No. To show that the nominated entity meets the Design Experience Requirements and Maintenance Experience Requirements, the following documents:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> For Design Experience Requirement, if to be met with the in-house experience of a telco, a copy of Detailed Engineering Design (or equivalent), which demonstrates the scope for completed design along with location and number of Billable End-Points including Mixed End User Base. Please refer to Section 4.2.1.(b)(ii). For Maintenance Experience Requirement, if to be met with the in-house experience of a telco, copies of Operational-Level Agreements, which demonstrate the service scope, service period, service scale (including Billable End-Points), performance of customer services, network availability and any other monitored performance metrics. The documents may also take the form of monthly Network Management Report, showing performance indicators such as fault repair times and fault rates. Please refer to Section 4.2.2.(b)2. <p>These documents can be supplemented, as necessary, with other relevant documents that contain the information specified above.</p> <p>Please be reminded that these documents must be accompanied by the notarized certification in EF-8 issued by the relevant officer of the project owner or authorized entity or the relevant officer of the entity which fulfills the experience requirement.</p>
