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| 1. Can we be advised on the extent of the commitment (infra build-up, capacity, site development plans, etc.) of the current companies? May we know the upcoming companies and their type of industry? | Please refer to Bid Bulletin No. 4 and Bid Bulletin No. 7 and its attached Supplemental Project Brief. |
| 2. Can we ask for a copy of the high-level feasibility study? | Please refer to Bid Bulletin No. 7 and its attached Supplemental Project Brief. |
| 3. Please clarify if the experience requirements around “seven (7) Integrated Networks” pertain to a single fiber network serving 7 telco providers. | <p>No. The seven (7) Integrated Networks requirement allows bidders to aggregate experience from up to seven (7) physical Integrated Networks to arrive at the total 100km underground optical fiber multi-conduit networks requirement. An Integrated Network must have the capability to interconnect to more than one (1) Data Transmission Provider (DTP), which may include telcos.</p> <p>Please refer to Bid Bulletin No. 9, which revises the definition of “Integrated Network” to: “a multi-conduit network with multiple fiber routes/cables built to a common design that serves an identifiable, contiguous area aggregated back to a central network site/connection point with capability for interconnection to the equipment of more than one (1) Data Transmission Provider (DTP)” (also reflected in Sec. 3.2.4.1. of the Revised IPSP Vol. 1 – Eligibility Documents).</p> |

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| | <p>In addition, a Prospective PSP applying for pre-qualification must also meet the technical capability requirements for design and configuration of passive wholesale network services using either:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Client-facing experience with service to at least two (2) DTPs (under Section 4.2.1(b)(iii).1 and Section 4.2.1(b)(vi).1 of Revised IPSP Vol. 1 – Eligibility Requirements); or2. In-house experience, if the nominated entity is a telecommunications company, with service to at least one (1) DTP (under Section 4.2.1(b)(iii).2 and Section 4.2.1(b)(vi).2 of Revised IPSP Vol. 1 – Eligibility Requirements). |
