RESOLUTION NO. 2024-006 (DECLARATION OF FAILURE OF BIDDING)

The BASES CONVERSION AND DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY (BCDA), through the 2024 BCDA Corporate Funds, has put on bid the CONSTRUCTION OF AIRSIDE ACCESS ROAD AT THE CLARK INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT with an Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) in the sum of Pesos: Forty-Five Million Eighteen Thousand Four Hundred Eight Pesos and 42/100 Centavos (Php 45,018,408.42), inclusive of all applicable taxes and fees.

WHEREAS, the BAC-I, through its Secretariat, advertised the Invitation to Bid on 13 February 2024 in the following platforms:

- a. DBM Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS);
- b. BCDA Website; and
- c. In a conspicuous place reserved for the purpose in the premises of BCDA.

WHEREAS, in response to the said advertisements, eighteen (18) prospective bidders bought the bid documents, namely:

WHEREAS, on 15 April 2024, the first envelopes which contained the Eligibility and Technical Requirements of the eleven (11) bidders were opened and subjected to a preliminary evaluation by determining the presence or absence of the required documents using the "pass/fail" criterion;

WHEREAS, during the said preliminary evaluation and after checking the sufficiency of the required documents as regards their presence or absence, the BAC-I declared that the bids of the following bidders "failed" due to the absence of the required documents or non-compliance with the requirements provided under the bidding documents for the project, to wit:

WHEREAS, the second envelopes which contained the financial proposals of the Three (3) bidders, who "passed" the preliminary examination of the eligibility/technical requirements, were opened and were likewise subjected to a preliminary evaluation of the financial proposals. After checking the sufficiency of the required documents as

WHEREAS, Section 32.2 of the RIRR of R.A. 9184 provides that, "For the procurement of Goods and Infrastructure Projects, the BAC shall evaluate the financial component of the bids to determine the Lowest Calculated Bid. xxx."


WHEREAS, on 16 to 22 April 2024, in accordance with Section 32.2 of the RIRR of R.A. 9184 mentioned above, the BAC Technical Working Group (TWG) conducted the detailed evaluation of the Financial Component of the bids of the aforementioned 3 proponents. After the said detailed evaluation of the Financial Component, the three (3) proponents were ranked in ascending order based on their financial bids or total bid price as calculated, evaluated, and/or corrected for computational errors, to identify the bidder with the Lowest Calculated Bid (LCB) who shall undergo the post-qualification. The table below shows the bid amount of the three (3) proponents (as calculated):

WHEREAS, the following bidders submitted a request for reconsideration, pursuant to Section 55.1 of the 2016 RIRR of RA 9184, and upon deliberation, the BAC-I has reached the following decisions:

WHEREAS, from April 23 to May 03, 2024, the BAC-I TWG conducted the Post-Qualification of Roma Construction and Development Corporation pursuant to Section 34 of the RIRR of R.A. 9184;

WHEREAS, on 06 May 2024, the BAC-I deliberated the Post-Qualification Report of BAC-I TWG. The results of Post-Qualification show that Roma Construction and Development Corporation was post-disqualified on 06 May 2024 due to its non-compliance with the requirements provided under the bidding documents for the project. Specifically on the following grounds.

meet the minimum required experience of at least 3 years.

Engr. Karen L. Reyes only has 2 years and 2 months of experience as a Quantity Surveyor as cited in the Relevant Work Experience portion of the Curriculum Vitae

2. As to Key Personnel, Antoine Kyle A. Hilario:

Based on the submitted Curriculum Vitae, the nominated key personnel for Site Engineer I did not meet the minimum required experience of at least 3 years.

Engr. Hilario only has 2 years and 8 months of experience as a Site Engineer I.

It was noted that Engr. Hilario was registered as Licensed Civil Engineer with PRC only on 02 December 2019. Thus, the period for which he is not yet a registered civil engineer must be excluded.

Section 21, Article IV of R.A. No. 544 (Civil Engineering Law) provides that:

"Unless exempt from registration, no person shall practice or offer to practice civil engineering in the Philippines without having obtained the proper certificate of registration stated in the Bidding Documents. These criteria shall consider, but shall not be limited to, the following:

Xxx

b) Technical Requirements. To determine compliance of the goods, infrastructure projects, or consulting services offered with the requirements specified in the Bidding Documents, including, where applicable:

i) Verification and validation the bidder's stated competence and experience, and competence and experience of the bidder's key personnel to be assigned to for the project, the procurement of Infrastructure Projects xxx;"

Relative thereto, ITB Clause 10.4 of the BDS provides that:

"The list of nominated personnel with the minimum required years of experience for the project are as follows:

Records show that Mr. Antoine Kyle A. Hilario obtained his license to practice on 02 December 2019

The reckoning date for the experience of the site engineer shall be counted from the date of his PRC registration.

Site Engineer

Two (2) of the nominated key personnel lack the required experience relative to the position, to wit:

- 1. The nominated quantity surveyor only has 2 years and 2 months of experience as a Quantity Surveyor based on the relevant Work Experience in the submitted CV.
- 2. One of the nominated Site Engineers only has 2 years and 8 months of experience as a PRC licensed Site Engineer based on the relevant Work Experience in the submitted CV.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 34.8 of the 2016 RIRR of RA 9184, the BAC-I approved and issued the Notice of Post Qualification to VVH Construction Corporation being the bidder with the next lowest calculated bid.

WHEREAS, on 08 May 2024, Roma Construction and Development Corporation submitted a request for reconsideration, pursuant to Section 55.1 of the 2016 RIRR of RA 9184, which was denied by the BAC-I on 13 May 2024.

WHEREAS, from May 07 to 15, 2024, the BAC-I TWG conducted the Post-Qualification on VVH Construction Corporation pursuant to Section 34 of the RIRR of R.A. 9184;

WHEREAS, on 16 May 2024, the BAC-I deliberated the Post-Qualification Report of BAC-I TWG. The results of Post-Qualification show that **VVH Construction Corporation** was post-disqualified on 16 May 2024 due to its non-compliance with the requirements provided under the bidding documents for the project. Specifically on the following grounds:

The TWG found that the following nominated key personnel lack the required number of years of experience prescribed under ITB clause 10.4 of the BDS:

Thus, the failure to submit the said documents within the 5-day period constitutes a violation of the aforementioned provisions. Consequently, the bid of VVH Construction Corporation should be considered as non-responsive.

Upon validation of the competence and experience of the bidder's key personnel pursuant to Section 34.3 of the RIRR of RA 9184, it was found that five (5) of the nominated key personnel lack the required experience relative to the position in violation of the ITB Clause 10.4 of the BDS, which states that:

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 34.8 of the 2016 RIRR of RA 9184, the BAC-I approved and issued the Notice of Post Qualification to **3 Sides Builders and Trading Corp.** being the bidder with the next lowest calculated bid.

WHEREAS, the BAC-I conducted the post-qualification of 3 Sides Builders and Trading Corp. on May 16 to 22, 2024, being ranked as the 3rd LCB of the subject bidding, but was declared post-disqualified on 27 May 2024 for being non-responsive and non-compliant with the bidding requirements for the project, as stated on the observations herein:

Section 34.2 of RA 9184 provides that:

"Within five (5) calendar days from receipt by the bidder of the notice from the BAC that the bidder has the Lowest Calculated Bid or Highest Rated Bid, the bidder shall submit to the BAC its latest income and business tax returns, and other appropriate licenses and permits required by law and stated in the Bidding Documents."

The bidder submitted the documents provided in the Instruction to Bidder ITB Clause 20 beyond the Five (5) days requirements of Section 34.2 of the RIRR of RA 9184.

Section 34.2 of RA 9184 provides that: "Within five (5) calendar days from receipt by the bidder of the notice from the BAC that the bidder has the Lowest Calculated Bid or Highest Rated Bid, the bidder shall submit to the BAC its latest income and business tax returns, and other appropriate licenses and permits required by law and stated in the Bidding Documents." This was further reiterated in Clause 20 of The Bid Data Sheet of the ITB which states

3. Valid PRC license ID of key personnel assigned (if the bidder submit expired PRC license together with the proof of renewal during the opening of the bids);

4. One (1) softcopy of its original bid in PDF format in USB Flash Drive. Incase of discrepancies and technical issues in the submitted drive, it shall not be a ground for disqualification and the original copy shall prevail in terms of its contents;

5. Proof of Capacity for the Post Qualification of submitted minimum required equipment such as but not limited to any of the following:

a. Manufacturer's Brochure

b. Bill of Lading

c. Valid OR/CR

d. Sales Invoice showing payment of VAT

WHEREAS, on 27 May 2024, the BAC-I deliberated the results of the Post-Qualification. Based on its findings, the Committee declared 3 Sides Builders and Trading Corporation as post-disqualified.

WHEREAS, BCDA did not receive within the prescribed period a request for reconsideration or protest from 3 Sides Builders and Trading Corporation, pursuant to Section 55 of the RIRR of R.A. 9184.

WHEREAS, based on the aforementioned, the BAC-I declares a failure of bidding, pursuant to the Section 35.1 of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (RIRR) of Republic Act (R.A.) No. 9184, to wit:

"35.1. The BAC shall declare the bidding failure when:

c) All bids fail to comply with all the bid requirements or fail post-qualification, or, in the case of Consulting Services, there is no successful negotiation; xxx"

NOW, THEREFORE, We, the Members of the Bids and Awards Committee for Infrastructure Projects, hereby RESOLVE as it is hereby RESOLVED the following:
