BID BULLETIN NO. 01

This Bid Bulletin contains clarifications raised during the Pre-Bid Conference held on 24 June 2024, as well as queries sent by prospective bidders via email, and other matters relating to the Project.

I. QUERIES/QUESTIONS BY THE PROSPECTIVE BIDDERS

Queries during the Pre-Bid Conference:	
<p>Q1. Bidding documents</p> <p>1. Whether bidders who purchased from the previous bidding are required to pay a separate fee for the bidding documents on this rebidding.</p> <p>2. Per GPPB, it was mentioned that payment for bidding documents shall be required during the rebidding if there were modifications in the BOQ and key technical personnel. Please clarify.</p>	<p>Yes, the bidders are required to pay a separate fee for the bidding documents on this rebidding.</p> <p>The Government Procurement and Policy Board (GPPB), in its NPM No. 51-2014, stated that the decision to charge bidders for the payment of Bidding Documents lies solely on the sound discretion of the Procuring Entity. A portion of which reads as follows:</p> <p>“Section 17.4 of the IRR of RA 9184 provides that bidders may be requested to pay for the Bidding Documents <u>to recover the cost of its preparation and development.</u></p> <p style="text-align: center;">xxx</p> <p>Considering that each bidding</p>

	<p>activity is <u>separate and distinct</u> from each other, even if they have the same subject-matter, the discretion to require payment for the Bidding Document covers both the first bidding and the re-bidding.”</p> <p style="text-align: center;">xxx</p>
<p>Q2. Whether the BCDA will provide a soft copy of the Pre-Bid Presentation.</p>	<p>Please refer to ANNEX A of this bid bulletin.</p>

<p>Q3. Whether we can still participate in the bidding despite our inability to attend the pre-bid conference.</p>	<p>Bidders who were not able to join the pre-bid conference can still participate in the bidding.</p>
<p>Q4. Can we ask for information regarding the mode of payment of bidding documents for these projects?</p>	<p>As per ITB Item No. 4:</p> <p>“xxx All payments of the applicable fee for the bidding documents pursuant to the guidelines issued by the GPPD, in the amount of Php 25,000 shall be made through online transfer or bank deposit to BCDA’s Landbank prior to issuance of the bidding documents. xxx”</p> <p>Payment through cash is also allowed. Please refer to <u>Section IV. Reminders - Item 1</u> of this Bid Bulletin.</p>
<p>Q5. Whether the BCDA would allow another conduct of site inspection.</p>	<p>The site inspection was already carried out last 27 July 2024.</p>

II. AMENDMENTS IN THE BIDDING DOCUMENTS

No.	REFERENCE	AMENDMENT
1	BDS Clause 11.1 (Note No. 3)	In filling out the bid form, bidders shall provide a discount offer in the form of amount, in figures, and in words, including its application and methodology. In case no discount is offered,, bidders shall write " None ", " - (dash) " or " 0 (zero) ".

III. COMMON REASONS FOR DISQUALIFICATION

1. Non-submission of any of the required documents in the technical and financial component of the bid.
2. Non-declaration of all ongoing contracts.
3. Incurring a negative slippage of at least 15% in any one project or at least 10% in each of 2 or more contracts.
4. Failure to present the exact equipment pledged in their bid submission due to various reasons.
5. Declaration of SLCC not contracted/completed.
6. Nomination of Key Personnel who has no valid license or does not meet the required qualifications.
7. Falsification of documents in the bid submission.
8. Incomplete submission of the Bill of Quantities.
9. Non-submission of proof of ownership as specified in the bidding documents.
10. Failure to indicate a discount on the Bid Form.
11. Non-compliance with existing labor laws and standards.

IV. REMINDERS

1. Only bidders who have purchased the bidding documents are allowed to submit their bids. Purchase of the bidding documents shall be until **12:00 PM of 05 August 2024**. The payment of the bidding documents in the amount of **Pesos: Twenty-Five Thousand (Php 25,000.00)** can be made in the form of cash or a manager's check.

2. Online payment, fund transfer, or over-the-counter deposit of Bidding Documents is allowed. Please use the following bank details:

3. The prospective bidders should send/email their proof of payment to BAC Secretariat at bacisec@bcda.gov.ph to facilitate validation of payment and the issuance of their official receipts as well as the copy of bidding documents can be picked up at the BCDA office on the 2nd Floor, Bonifacio Technology Center, 31st Street Corner 2nd Avenue, Crescent Parkwest, Bonifacio Global City, Taguig.
4. **Receipt of Bids.** Bids must be duly received by the BAC Secretariat through manual/physical submission at the BCDA Office, BCDA Corporate Center, 2nd Floor Bonifacio Technology Center, 31st Street Corner 2nd Avenue, Crescent Parkwest, Bonifacio Global City Taguig, on or before **12:00 PM of 05 August 2024**. Late bids shall not be accepted.

The bidders may submit their bid proposal before the deadline for submission of bids to avoid late submission. The computer system clock at the CRRA that is set to Philippine Standard Time (PhST) shall be used as a reference in determining the time for the submission of bids. Hence, participating bidders are advised to synchronize their timepieces with the said computer system clock.

ONLINE BID SUBMISSION IS NOT ALLOWED.

5. The bid should **NOT** be more than the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC), otherwise, the bidder will be disqualified.
6. **Opening of Bids.** Bid Opening shall be on **05 August 2024, 1:00 PM** at the BCDA Office, BCDA Corporate Center, 2nd Floor Bonifacio Technology Center, 31st Street Corner 2nd Avenue, Crescent Parkwest, Bonifacio Global City, Taguig.

The BAC expects the bidders to exercise due diligence in going through the bidding documents to be able to prepare their bids intelligently.

7. The Bidders are requested to use tabs in compiling their bid documents for quick and easy identification and verification.
8. The computation of the Bid Security shall be based on the ABC. The bidders may submit a notarized Bid Securing Declaration in lieu of other forms of bid security. It is important to note, however, that although the Bid Securing Declaration does not require cash, its enforcement will include automatic blacklisting and payment of certain fines in the event that the bidder violates any of the conditions set forth in the bidding documents.
9. Visiting or calling (including sending text messages) the members of the BAC-I, the TWG, the Secretariat (except for administrative matters relating to the project), or anyone working in BCDA is prohibited and will not be entertained. All queries should be addressed to the BAC-I Chairperson and emailed or sent through written correspondence to the Secretariat until the deadline for requests for clarification.

This Bid Bulletin shall be considered as an integral part of the Bidding Documents for the aforementioned Project. All other provisions and statements in the Bidding Documents or previous Supplemental/Bid Bulletin/s that are inconsistent with this Bid Bulletin are deemed amended or modified.
