RESOLUTION NO. 2024-007 DECLARATION OF LOWEST CALCULATED AND RESPONSIVE BID (LCRB)

The BASES CONVERSION AND DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY (BCDA), through the General Appropriations Act (GAA), has put on bid the **SITE DEVELOPMENT OF THE 65-HECTARE RELOCATION SITE IN NEW CLARK CITY (NCC)** with an Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) in the sum of **Pesos: Seven Hundred Nineteen Million Nine Hundred Seventy Two Thousand One Hundred Eighty Three Pesos 45/100 Centavos (Php 719,972,183.45), inclusive of all applicable taxes and fees.**

WHEREAS, the BAC-I, through its Secretariat, advertised the Invitation to Bid on 01 March 2024 in the following platforms:

- a. DBM Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS);
- b. BCDA Website; and
- c. In a conspicuous place reserved for the purpose in the premises of BCDA.

WHEREAS, in response to the said advertisements, eleven (11) prospective bidders bought the bid documents, namely:

- 11. ED1SON DEVELOPMENT CONSTRUCTION, INC.

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WHEREAS, out of the aforementioned interested bidders, eight (8) submitted their bids prior to the set deadline of submission of bids for the project on 22 April 2024 at 9:00AM:

- 1. JC RODRIGUEZ CONSTRUCTION CORPORATION
- 2. ED1SON DEVELOPMENT AND CONSTRUCTION INC.
- 3. FFJJ CONSTRUCTION
- 4. RD POLICARPIO & CO. INC.
- 5. JV OF PRIME GIGA BUILD CONSTRUCTION CORP. AND ZED BUILDERS, INC.
- 6. MAC BUILDERS CORP.
- 7. PHESCO INCORPORATED
- 8. JV OF KAEL CONSTRUCTION AND SUPPLY AND DRAGONHART CONSTRUCTION ENTERPRISE, INC.

WHEREAS, on 22 April 2024, the first envelopes which contained the Eligibility and Technical Requirements of the eight (8) proponents were opened and subjected to a preliminary evaluation by determining the presence or absence of the required documents using the "pass/fail" criterion;

WHEREAS, during the said preliminary evaluation and after checking the sufficiency of the required documents as regards their presence or absence, the BAC declared that the bids of the following bidders "failed" due to the absence of the required documents or non-compliance with the requirements provided under the bidding documents for the project, to wit:

7400	"Subcontract Agreements shall not be considered in the satisfaction of the Single Largest Completed Contract (SLCC) requirement."

WHEREAS, the second envelopes which contained the financial proposals of the seven (7) proponents, who "passed" the preliminary examination of the eligibility/technical requirements, were opened and were likewise subjected to a

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preliminary evaluation of the financial proposals. After checking the sufficiency of the required documents as regards its presence or absence, the BAC declared the bids of the six (6) proponents "passed" and were considered for the detailed evaluation and comparison of financial bids. The table below shows the ranking and bid amounts of the 6 proponents (as read):

WHEREAS, during the said preliminary evaluation and after checking the sufficiency of the required documents as regards its presence or absence, the BAC-I declared the Financial Bid of one (1) bidder as "failed" due to the non-compliance with the requirements of ITB clause 11.1 provided under the bidding documents for the project, and the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (RIRR) of Republic Act (R.A) No. 9184, to wit:

The bidder is non compliant with ITB Clause No. 11.1 of the Bid Data Sheet which is clearly instructive that, in case the bidder will offer no discount, the word "None" shall be written. The pertinent clause states as follows: In filling out the bid form, bidders shall provide a discount offer in the form of amount, in figures and in words, including its

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application and methodology. In case of no discount offered, bidders shall write "None."

WHEREAS. Section 32.2 of the RIRR of R.A. 9184 provides that, "For the procurement of Goods and Infrastructure Projects, the BAC shall evaluate the financial component of the bids to determine the Lowest Calculated Bid. xxx."

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 32.2 of the RIRR of R.A. 9184 mentioned above, the BAC Technical Working Group (TWG) conducted the detailed evaluation of the Financial Component of the bids of the aforementioned six (6) proponents on 23 April to 26 April 2024. After the said detailed evaluation of the Financial Component, the BAC declared the Financial Bid of one (1) bidder as "failed" due to non-compliance with the requirements provided under the bidding documents for the project, to wit:

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quantities, shall be considered non-responsive and, thus, automatically disqualified. <u>In this regard, where a required item is provided, but no price is indicated, the same shall be considered as non-responsive, but specifying a zero (0) or a dash (-) for the said item would mean that it is being offered for free to the Government, except those required by law or regulations to be provided for:"</u>

Thus, only the bids of the five (5) proponents were ranked in ascending order based on their financial bids or total bid price as calculated, evaluated, and/or corrected for computational errors, to identify the bidder with the Lowest Calculated Bid (LCB) who shall undergo the post-qualification. WHEREAS, based on the above results of the detailed evaluation conducted by the BAC-I TWG, the BAC-I found **JV OF PRIME GIGA BUILD CONSTRUCTION CORP & ZED BUILDERS, INC.** as the bidder with the Lowest Calculated Bid (LCB) which shall undergo the Post-Qualification process pursuant to Section 34 of the RIRR of R.A. 9184;

WHEREAS, the following bidders submitted a request for reconsideration, pursuant to Section 55.1 of the 2016 RIRR of RA 9184, and upon deliberation, the BAC-I has reached the following decisions:

WHEREAS, from April 30 to May 09, 2024, the BAC-I TWG conducted the Post-Qualification of **JV of Prime Giga Build Construction Corporation and Zed Builders Inc.** pursuant to Section 34 of the RIRR of R.A. 9184;

WHEREAS, on 10 May 2024, the BAC-I deliberated the Post-Qualification Report of BAC-I TWG. The results of Post-Qualification show that the JV of **Prime Giga Build Construction Corporation and Zed Builders Inc.** was post-disqualified on 10 May 2024 due to its non-compliance with the requirements provided under the bidding documents for the project. Specifically on the following grounds.

1. As to Key Personnel, Engr. Jigo C. Aliangan:

Based on the submitted Curriculum Vitae, the nominated key personnel for Highway/Road Engineer did not meet the minimum required experience of at least 3 years.

Engr. Jigo C. Aliangan has No declared experience as Highway/ Road Engineer as cited in the Relevant Work Experience portion of the Curriculum Vitae. Moreover, Relevant Work Experience portion shows that he had been performing as Project tasks Manager, Office Engineer, Superintendent, Project Project Engineer and Cadet Engineer which are different from or are not relevant to position Highway/Road Engineer.

2. As to Key Personnel, Engr. Julie Ann M. Calderon:

Based on the submitted Curriculum Vitae, the nominated key personnel for Quantity Surveyor did not meet the minimum required experience of at least 3 years.

Engr. Calderon has No declared experience as a Quantity Surveyor.

"The post-qualification shall verify, validate and ascertain the veracity, authenticity and validity of xxx all the other statements made and documents submitted by the bidder with the Lowest Calculated Bid / Highest Rated Bid, using non-discretionary criteria, as the Bidding stated in Documents. These criteria shall consider, but shall not be limited to, the following:

b) Technical Requirements. To determine compliance of the goods, infrastructure projects, or consulting services offered with the requirements specified in the Bidding Documents, including, where applicable:

i) Verification and validation bidder's of the stated competence and experience, and competence the and experience of the bidder's key personnel to be assigned to the project, for the procurement Infrastructure Projects xxx;"

Relative thereto, ITB Clause 10.4 of the BDS provides that:

The list of nominated personnel with the minimum required years of experience for the project are as follows:

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Moreover, the Relevant Work Experience portion shows that she had been performing actual tasks as Head Office Engineer and Office Engineer which were unidentifiable for being a Quantity Surveyor, Environment Designer and QA/QC which are different from or are not relevant to the nominated position as Quantity Surveyor.

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WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 34.8 of the 2016 RIRR of RA 9184, the BAC-I approved and issued the Notice of Post Qualification to Phesco Incorporated being the bidder with the next lowest calculated bid.

WHEREAS, on 13 May 2024, JV of Prime Giga Build Construction Corporation and Zed Builders Inc. submitted a request for reconsideration, pursuant to Section 55.1 of the 2016 RIRR of RA 9184, which was denied by the BAC-I on 20 May 2024.

WHEREAS, from May 11 to 17, 2024, the BAC-I TWG conducted the Post-Qualification on Phesco Incorporated pursuant to Section 34 of the RIRR of R.A. 9184;

WHEREAS, on 20 May 2024, the BAC-I deliberated the Post-Qualification Report of BAC-I TWG. The results of Post-Qualification show that Phesco Incorporated was post-disgualified on 20 May 2024 due to its non-compliance with the requirements provided under the bidding documents for the project. Specifically on the following grounds:

In addition, GPPB NPM No. 006-2018 explained that "if the bidder fails to declare an government ongoing and private contracts 'Statement of all on-going private and government contracts', including contracts awarded but not yet started, if any, whether similar or not similar in nature and complexity to the contract to be including immaterial contract, is a ground for disqualification.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 34.8 of the 2016 RIRR of RA 9184, the BAC-I approved and issued the Notice of Post Qualification to **J.C Rodriguez Construction Corp.** being the bidder with the next lowest calculated bid.

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WHEREAS, BCDA did not receive within the prescribed period a request for reconsideration or protest from **Phesco Incorporated**, pursuant to Section 55.1 of the RIRR of R.A. 9184.

WHEREAS, from May 21 to June 03, 2024, the BAC-I TWG conducted the Post-Qualification on **J.C. Rodriguez Construction Corp.** pursuant to Section 34 of the RIRR of R.A. 9184;

WHEREAS, on 03 June 2024, the BAC-I deliberated the Post-Qualification Report of BAC-I TWG. The results of Post-Qualification show that **J.C. Rodriguez** was post-disqualified on 03 June 2024 due to its non-compliance with the requirements provided under the bidding documents for the project. Specifically on the following grounds:

Non declaration of one (1) ongoing private project.

During the conduct of validation, as a result of the extension Post of the TWG Qualification, observed that one (1)ongoing project as shown in website the was not declared in the list of ongoing projects.

The bidder was only able to provide Certificate of Provisional Acceptance, signed by the project owner's President and CEO, which states the following:

"This is to certify that the Contractor, I.C. RODRIGUEZ CONSTRUCTION CORPORATION has substantially completed all the works required under the Contract the for **CONSTRUCTION** OF ROADWAYS AND UNDERGROUND UTILITIES AT LISP IVNORTH SITE, located at the

With adverse findings

Section 23.1(a)(iv) of the 2016 Revised IRR of RA 9184 requires that the bidder must state <u>all</u> of its ongoing government and private contracts, including contracts awarded but not yet started, if any, whether or not similar in nature and complexity to the contract to be bid.

It can be gleaned from the Certificate of Provisional Acceptance issued by the project owner, that the works for the construction of roadways and underground utilities at LISP IV North Site is only "substantially completed".

The word "substantially completed" denotes that the project is sufficiently complete for its intended purpose, whereas Final Completion indicates that all work has been fully finished, including the resolution of any

NOW, THEREFORE, this Certificate of Provisional Acceptance is issued as of this date November 14, 2023 pursuant to the provisions of ARTICLE X of the Contract." outstanding issues or deficiencies not covered by the Defects Liability Period. Since the project is still considered as ongoing, it should have been declared by the bidder.

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WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 34.8 of the 2016 RIRR of RA 9184, the BAC-I approved and issued the Notice of Post Qualification to **R.D. Policarpio & Co. Inc.** being the bidder with the next lowest calculated bid.

WHEREAS, on 04 June 2024, **J.C Rodriguez Construction Corp.** submitted a request for reconsideration, pursuant to Section 55.1 of the 2016 RIRR of RA 9184, which was denied by the BAC-I on 12 June 2024.

WHEREAS, from 04 to 13 June 2024, the BAC-I TWG conducted the Post-Qualification on **R.D. Policarpio & Co. Inc.** pursuant to Section 34 of the RIRR of R.A. 9184;

WHEREAS, on 14 June 2024, the BAC-I deliberated the results of the Post-Qualification based on the following findings as shown in the table below:
