

However, since these properties are used and scrap materials, customs duties may not apply. Also, all expenses incidental to the withdrawal of the properties shall be borne
		by the winning bidder.

III. OTHER CLARIFICATIONS

SUBMISSION AND OPENING OF BIDS:

- 1. Bidders shall submit their Bids in a single sealed envelope containing the following:
 - Copy of the Invitation to Bid for the Disposal Through Sale of One (1) Lot of Used Vehicle Spare Parts and Assorted Scrap Materials - with all pages duly signed or initialed by the authorized representative;
 - ii. Copy of the Instruction to Bidders with all pages duly signed or initialed by the authorized representative;
 - iii. Certified True Copy of Valid Business Permit / Mayor's Permit;

iv. Copy of Official Receipt/Invoice evidencing payment of bidding documents;

v. Financial Bid Form (attached as Annex A Financial Bid Form in the Bidding Documents) duly signed by the authorized representative;

vi. Authorization Letter (Annex B of the Bidding Documents) or <u>any</u> <u>equivalent document</u> signed by the owner or the company's appropriate authority; and

vii. Auction Bond (not less than ten (10%) percent of the floor price - (Php 950.25)

Note: Incomplete submission of the above-mentioned documents shall be a ground for disqualification.

PAYMENT

- 1. The full payment of the Bid Tender shall be made within five (5) working days from the date of Notice Of Award (NOA) or not later than 05 November 2024;
- 2. However, should the winning bidder wish to pay early, BCDA shall be open on 31 October 2024 until 12:00 PM only.

AUCTION BOND

- 1. Auction bonds of non-winning bidders shall be returned immediately after the announcement of the winning bidder. However, for the winning bidder, the auction bond shall be returned only upon completion of the hauling activities.
- 2. Unjustified failure to withdraw the properties within the fixed period set shall be grounds for the forfeiture of the auction bond.

AWARDING OF SALE

- 1. Award for the Lot shall be given to the highest complying bidder; and
- 2. When two (2) or more complying bidders have identical offers, public auction by viva voce between those who made identical auctions shall be resorted to at a price not less than the offered auction, immediately on the same day if both bidders or their authorized representative are present either physically or through video conferencing or similar platform.



- 1. Submission of falsified documents containing false information;
- 2. Withdrawal of an auction tender, or refusal to accept an award without justifiable cause after the auction tender has been declared as the highest offer; or
- 3. Non-compliance by bidders to the provisions stipulated under the agency's Invitation to Bid, Instructions to Bidders, and/or Terms of Reference.

BID BULLETINS

The Bid Bulletins shall be considered an integral part of the Bidding Documents (Invitation to Bid, Instruction to Bidders, and Bidding Forms). All other provisions and statements in the Bidding Documents or previous Supplemental/Bid Bulletin/s that are inconsistent with this Bid Bulletin are deemed amended or modified.













