Contract for the Procurement of Additional Fifty (50) Security Guards for Camp John Hay

PASILIAO who is duly authorized for this purpose as evidence by be no. 1132 2004 a copy of which is hereto attached as Annex "B"

WHEREAS, the BCDA invited Bids for certain goods and ancillary services, particularly the Procurement of additional fifty (50) Security Guards for Camp John Hay and has accepted a Bid by the Supplier for the supply of those goods and services in the sum of Eleven Million Five Hundred Ninety One Thousand Nine Hundred Ninety Four Pesos and 00/100 (Php11,591,994.00) plus VAT of Two Hundred Thirty Four Thousand Pesos and 00/100 (Php234,000.00) (hereinafter called "the Contract Price").

NOW THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. In this Agreement words and expressions shall have the same meanings as are respectively assigned to them in the Conditions of Contract referred to.
- 2. The following documents as required by the 2016 revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9184 shall be deemed to form and be read and construed as integral part of this Agreement, *viz.*:
 - i. Philippine Bidding Documents (PBDs);
 - i. Schedule of Requirements;
 - ii. Technical Specifications;
 - iii. General and Special Conditions of Contract; and

- iv. Supplemental or Bid Bulletins, if any
- ii. Winning bidder's bid, including the Eligibility requirements, Technical and Financial Proposals, and all other documents or statements submitted;


Bid form, including all the documents/statements contained in the Bidder's bidding envelopes, as annexes, and all other documents submitted (*e.g.*, Bidder's response to request for clarifications on the bid), including corrections to the bid, if any, resulting from the Procuring Entity's bid evaluation;

- iii. Performance Security;
- iv. Notice of Award of Contract; and the Bidder's conforme thereto; and
- v. Other contract documents that may be required by existing laws and/or the Procuring Entity concerned in the PBDs. Winning bidder agrees that additional contract documents or information prescribed by the GPPB that are subsequently required for submission after the contract execution, such as the Notice to Proceed, Variation Orders, and Warranty Security, shall likewise form part of the Contract.
- 3. In consideration for the sum of Eleven Million Five Hundred Ninety One Thousand Nine Hundred Ninety Four Pesos and 00/100 (Php11,591,994.00) plus VAT of Two Hundred Thirty Four Thousand Pesos and 00/100 (Php234,000.00) or such other sums as may be ascertained, Urduja Security Services Inc., agrees to Procurement of additional fifty (50) Security Guards for Camp John Hay in accordance with his/her/its Bid.
- 4. The BCDA agrees to pay the above-mentioned sum in accordance with the terms of the Bidding.
- 5. Anti-Bribery. The contractor has not made and will not make any offer, promise to pay, or authorization of the payment of any money, gift or any other inducement to any official, political party, employee of Government or any other person, in contravention with applicable laws in connection with the execution of this Contract and performance of its obligations thereunder. Violation of the provision shall be a ground for immediate termination of this contract.
- 6. Assignment. Contractor shall not assign this contract or sub-contract any portion of it, without BCDA's prior written consent. Prior to the

assignment or subcontracting and the approval by BCDA thereof, Contractor must disclose to BCDA the name of its assignee/s or subcontractor who/which should have a written agreement/s with Contractor indicating: (i) that the assignee/s or subcontractor/s is aware and shall abide with all the terms and conditions of this Contract, as may be applicable, (ii) that the terms of the assignments/subcontract shall not exceed the term of this Contract, and (iii) the detailed terms of the assignment/subcontract.

- 7. To ensure continuing compliance with tax laws pursuant to Executive Order No. 398:
 - a. Contractor shall pay taxes in full and on time.
 - b. Contractor is likewise required to regularly present, within the duration of the Contract, a tax clearance from the Bureau of Internal Revenue (BIR) as well as copy of its income and business tax returns duly stamped and received by the BIR and duly validated with the tax payments made therein.
