This Bid Bulletin clarifies the queries raised during the Pre-bid Conference on 29 July 2025 at 3:00 PM and other matters related to the above Project.

A. QUERIES/QUESTIONS FROM THE PROSPECTIVE BIDDERS

1.	Whether the prospective bidders can send an email for the reconsideration of the Technical Specifications.	The technical specifications attached and uploaded in the bidding documents are the minimum technical specifications determined by the end-users. Yes. Prospective bidders can send an email for the reconsideration of the Technical Specifications subject for review and approval of the end-users.
2.	Clarification on the number of years of experience in the Philippine Market. Whether a 10 year experience can be considered.	Yes. The companies and prospective bidders with at least 10 years of experience in the Philippine Market shall be considered.
3.	Clarification on the Single Largest Completed Contract (SLCC), whether the prospective bidders without projects related to delivery of hybrid vehicles can be considered.	No. Prospective Bidders without projects related to the delivery of HYBRID ELECTRIC VEHICLES (HEV) cannot be considered. The Single Largest Completed Contract (SLCC) shall pertain to "Hybrid Electric Vehicle" for Lots B & C.
4.	Clarification on the Technical Specification: Lot E - Tow Truck Deck Dim: 6605 x 2496 mm Whether the prospective bidders may suggest a dimension of 6550mm.	No. The end user will stick with the specifications as stated in the bid documents. Please take note that our specifications are just minimum requirements and we can accommodate equal or higher specifications.

Clarification on the Technical Specification: Lot E - Tow Truck One (1) Unit Custom Built Whether the color, yellow with Multi-reflector includes the cab and/or body.	As stated in the Technical Specifications and as a general requirement, prospective bidders must be guided that both the cab and the body shall be of yellow color.
Clarification on the submission of the Single Largest Completed Contract (SLCC) on the lot/s that the prospective bidders intend to join. Whether the prospective bidders shall submit an SLCC reflecting the specific lots/s.	Yes. The prospective bidders shall submit the required SLCC reflecting the specific lot that the prospective bidders intend to join. As specified in the bidding documents, the prospective bidders must be guided with the specific similar project per lot.
Clarification on Section VII. Technical Specifications Form. Whether the prospective bidders shall just indicate their compliance in the corresponding column.	The prospective bidders shall indicate the following, as applicable, to indicate their compliance with the Technical Specifications: • Comply • Not Comply • Not Applicable
Clarification on the Checklist of Financial Requirements, whether the legal documents indicated in the PhilGEPS registration and certificate must be updated. Whether the Annual Financial Statement (AFS) Report for CY 2023 is still acceptable.	Yes. Prospective bidders must be guided that all legal documents indicated in the PhilGEPS registration and certificate must be updated. Yes. The AFS Report for CY 2023 is still acceptable. Pursuant to Section 23.1 (a) (vii) of the 2016 RIRR of RA No. 9184, to wit: "vii) The bidder's audited financial statements, showing, among others, the bidder's total and current assets and liabilities, stamped "received" by the BIR or its duly accredited and authorized institutions, for the preceding calendar year which should not be earlier than two (2) years from the date of bid submission."





The prospective bidders must be guided that indicating a "Not Comply" remark shall render its bid as invalid or not compliant for the specific Lot. This will constitute prospective bidders' ineligibility to bid for that specific lot.
The prospective bidders must be guided that there are no required specific colors for the eligibility, technical and financial envelopes. The prospective bidders are requested to USE TABS in compiling the bid documents for easier identification and verification.
Yes. The prospective bidders who will join in several/all lots must be guided that all legal documents will be considered for all the lots. However, prospective bidders must ensure the specific requirements per lot such as the Bid Security, SLCC requirement, etc.
The prospective bidders must be guided by the following, on a per lot basis:
 Lot B - preferred color is still for approval of BCDA management, the winning bidder will be advised accordingly Lot C - Pearl White
The prospective bidders may refer to the bidding documents for the specifications of the captain seats.

Please be guided that the captain seats are subject to the final approval of the end-user prior to the delivery of the motor vehicles.

14. Whether the winning bidder may request an extension of the delivery period of the motor vehicles from 60 days to 180 days?

The winning bidder must be guided that the BCDA will allow the extension up to 90 days only for Lots B & C.

The prospective bidders must attach the updated schedule of requirements in its bid submissions.
