**RESOLUTION NO. BG-2025-022
(FAILURE OF BIDDING)**

WHEREAS, the **BASES CONVERSION AND DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY (BCDA)**, through its 2024 Corporate Operating Budget (COB), has bid out the Supply and Delivery of Ten (10) Brand New Motor Vehicles with an Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) of **THIRTY-FOUR MILLION FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS (Php34,500,000.00)**, inclusive of VAT and all other applicable government taxes, fees, and charges;

WHEREAS, the Bids and Awards Committee for Goods (BAC-G) advertised/posted the Invitation to Bid, including the bidding document on 15 July 2025 in the following platforms:

- a. Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS) website;
- b. BCDA Website; and
- c. In a conspicuous place reserved for the purpose in the premises of BCDA.

WHEREAS, BAC-G conducted a Pre-bid Conference on 29 July 2025, which was attended by the following prospective bidders:

- a. Alpine Motors Corporation;
- b. World Solution Technology, Inc.;
- c. One Top Medical Systems Resources;
- d. Toyota Otis, Inc.;
- e. Autokid Subic Trading Corporation;
- f. Toyota Pasong Tamo, Inc.;
- g. Global Excellence Motors Inc. (GEMI);
- h. United Asia Automotive Group, Inc.;

WHEREAS, in response to the advertisement, two (2) bidders submitted their bids before the deadline of submission on 12 August 2025 (Tuesday) at 9:00 AM at the BCDA Corporate Center, Bonifacio Global City, Taguig City;

1. One Top Medical Systems Resources
2. Toyota Pasong Tamo, Inc.

WHEREAS, during the Opening of Bids on 12 August 2025 (Tuesday) at 10:00 AM, BAC-G opened the bid submission of the two (2) bidders and subjected to a preliminary evaluation by determining the presence or absence of the required documents using the "pass/fail" criterion;

WHEREAS, during the said preliminary evaluation and after checking the sufficiency of the required documents as regards their presence or absence, the BAC-G declared the bids of the

following bidders as “failed” due to the non-compliance with the requirements provided under the bidding documents for the project, to wit:

The Abstract of Bids as Read is hereto attached as “Annex A”;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 30.1 of the 2016 RIRR of RA No. 9184, to wit:

“30.1 The BAC shall open the first bid envelopes in public to determine each bidder’s compliance with the documents required to be submitted for eligibility and for the technical requirements, as prescribed in this IRR. For this purpose, the BAC shall check the submitted documents of each bidder against a checklist of required documents to ascertain if they are all present, using a non-discretionary “pass/fail” criterion, as stated in the Instructions to Bidders. If a bidder submits the required document, it shall be rated “passed” for that particular requirement. In this regard, bids that fail to include any requirement or are incomplete or patently insufficient shall be considered as “failed.” Otherwise, the BAC shall rate the said first bid envelope as “passed.” (Emphasis supplied);

WHEREAS, BAC-G declared a failure of bidding for the **Supply and Delivery of Ten (10) Brand New Motor Vehicles** pursuant to Section 35.1 of the 2016 RIRR of RA 9184, viz:

“35.1 The BAC shall declare the bidding a failure when:

xxx

- c) All bids fail to comply with all the bid requirements or fail post-qualification, or, in the case of Consulting Services, there is no successful negotiation;

xxx”

NOW, THEREFORE, We, the Members of the Bids and Awards Committee for Goods, hereby **RESOLVE** as it is hereby **RESOLVED** to recommend the following:

1. To declare a Failure of Bidding for the **Supply and Delivery of Ten (10) Brand New Motor Vehicles** in accordance with Section 35.1 of the 2016 RIRR of RA 9184; and
2. To direct the end-user, **Property and Procurement Management Department - General Services Division (PPMD-GSD)**, to conduct a mandatory review and evaluation of the terms, conditions, and specifications of the Bidding Documents, including the cost estimates, and other requirements relative to this procurement, pursuant to Section 35.2 of the 2016 RIRR of RA 9184.
