TERMS OF REFERENCE (TOR)

FILTRATION PUMP REPAIR AT ATHLETIC'S STADIUM

I. BACKGROUND:

The Bases Conversion and Development Authority (BCDA) intends to engage the services of a licensed service provider for the repair of pumps in the Athletics Stadium (Pitch Area) and Aquatic Center (Swimming Pool) at the Managed Property, New Clark City Sports Facilities, Brgy. Aranguren, Capas, Tarlac. The objective of this TOR is to restore full functionality and improve efficiency and operational reliability of the facilities, ensuring compliance with technical, safety, and environmental standards.

II. SCOPE OF WORK, DELIVERABLES AND QUALIFICATIONS:

The selected service provider shall undertake comprehensive repair of the pumps in Athletics Stadium, specifically at Pitch Area, and at the Aquatic Center's Competition Pool. The scope includes, but is not limited to the following:

5	pcs	Replacement of Filtration Filter Top Lid Cover (Aquatic Center's Competition Pool) -Flexi-glass bottle-type fabrication lid cover
5	units	Rewinding of Submersible Pump (Athletics Stadium Pitch Area) -Replace the new bearing -Replace the new mechanical shaft seal -General cleaning and repainting -Replace O-ring set

1. Dismantling Filter Pump

- a. Replacement of High-Speed Bearing
 - Remove worn or damaged high-speed bearings and install new, or approved equivalent high-speed bearings.
- b. Replacement of Mechanical Seal
 - Remove the existing and install a new mechanical seal compatible with the existing pump system.
- c. Pull-Out of Bearing for Machine Shop Processing
 - Extract the bearing assembly for servicing at an external machine shop and perform reconditioning, polishing, or replacement, as necessary.
- d. Cleaning of Residues and Repainting
 - Remove all accumulated debris, rust, and chemical residue from the pump casing and components. Then apply industrial-grade, corrosion-resistant paint to all external surfaces of the pump to protect against environmental wear and tear.

2. Dismantle 12 Units of Butterfly Valves

- a. Cleaning of Stocked-Up Valves
 - Remove all internal buildup, dirt, and mineral deposits. Ensure valves operate freely and reseal properly after cleaning, and apply food-grade lubricant or sealing agent if required.
- 3. Mounting of Repaired Pump and Installation of New Lid Cover at Water Flow Filter
 - Reassemble and reinstall the serviced pump at its designated location, ensuring alignment and secure mounting to prevent vibration and ensure performance.
 - Install a new, properly fitted lid cover on the water flow filter unit and ensure it is leak-free and aligned with filter housing specifications.

4. Mobilization

Transport all required tools, materials, personnel, and equipment to the project site and conduct pre-work briefings, safety orientation, and site preparation.

5. Demobilization

 Clean the site of all waste, materials, and tools after completion of work. Transport equipment and personnel out of the site then submit a completion report and turnover checklist to the client.

II. DELIVERY PERIOD

The delivery period of all scope of work shall be Thirty (30) Calendar Days from the date of Purchase Order or receipt of Notice to proceed.

IV. APPROVED BUDGET FOR THE CONTRACT

Eight Hundred Ninety One Thousand Eight Hundred Thirty Three and 60/100 Pesos only (Php 891,833.60) inclusive of VAT and all applicable government taxes and fees, chargeable to the BCDA General Appropriations Act (GAA).

The ABC shall be the upper limit or ceiling for the bid prices. Bid prices that exceed the ABC shall be disqualified outright. Bidders shall submit proposals for all line items. Evaluation and contract award will be undertaken as a whole for the project. The Lowest Calculated bidder will be based on the total Amount bidded for the project.

V. WARRANTY

In order to assure that manufacturing defects shall be corrected by the Supplier, a warranty security shall be required from the contract awardee for a minimum period of one (1) year after acceptance by the BCDA of the delivered supplies in accordance with Section 62.1 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184.

The obligation for the warranty shall be covered by the retention money in an amount equivalent to 5% of the total contract price. The said amounts shall only be released after the lapse of the warranty period.

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
